Episode 10 – Dead End

The player combines August 13, 1961, the day the Berlin Wall was built, and November 9, 1989 when it fell. The success of the mission depends on something to do with those dates. But what should Anna do?

Paul and Anna take refuge in the department store KaDeWe where Anna does her game save. The player tells Anna that the Berlin Wall was built on August 13, 1961 and fell on November 9, 1989. Anna realises the key to the whole mission is the division of Berlin.

Manuscript of the Episode

INTRODUCTION

COMPUTER:

Mission Berlin. November 9, 2006, ten forty-five am. You've got 65 minutes and one life left.

FLASHBACK:

"Nostalgie" von Friedrich August Dachfeg. Unsere Melodie, Anna!

COMPUTER:

Is there even more to know? Do you want to play? Do you want to play?

SITUATION 1 – Im KaDeWe

SPIELER:

Anna, let's tap into Paul's memory and don't forget those dates!

PAUL:

Anna, komm, schnell, hier rein ... ins KaDeWe, hier finden sie uns nicht.

ANNA:

Ka De We? Letters?

PAUL:

Ja, Kaufhaus des Westens.

Oh, it's all ... It's all decked out for Christmas.

PAUL:

Ja, bald ist Weihnachten. Mit all den Lichtern und Farben ... blau, rot, gold und silber ...

ANNA:

Oh, Paul, look, schön!

PAUL:

Ah, der kleine Bär, gefällt er dir? Der Bär ist das Wahrzeichen von Berlin.

ANNA:

Bär? Oh, Berlin, of course, the bear, the bear is the symbol of Berlin.

PAUL:

Möchtest du ihn haben?

ANNA:

Oh, Paul! Aber was hat der Bär? Was ist das, Paul? Is that a piece of concrete I can see?

PAUL:

Ach das, ja, das ist ein Stück von der Berliner Mauer ... Moment, mein Handy!

DECODAGE 1

SPIELER:

Oh, Paul! – bear ...

ANNA:

Yes, yes, yes, all right ...

SPIELER:

What kind of present is that ? Ein Bär ... a bear – all in red ... rot. With a chunk of the Berlin Wall in his arms.

ANNA:

Wall, hm, ... Mauer ... Berliner Mauer?

SPIELER:

After it came down, people grabbed bits as souvenirs and now they're up for sale if you can get hold of a piece.

ANNA:

But what about "Kaufhaus des Westens"?

SPIELER:

... is the famous department store founded in 1907.

SITUATION 2 – Save Game

PAUL:

Winkler.

COMPUTER:

Back up required. Save changes now.

PAUL:

Ja, Moment, ich gebe sie Ihnen. Anna, noch ein Anruf für dich.

ANNA:

Hello?

COMPUTER:

Enter mission update. Enter mission update.

ANNA:

My mission is to prevent a catastrophe which will have serious consequences for Germany. A woman approached me at a fun fair claiming that we knew each other.

FLASHBACK:

Ich bin Heidrun, Heidrun Drei. Neunzehnhunderteinundsechzig.

ANNA:

First: The numbers 19610813 relate to a date, the 13th of August, 1961.

ANNA:

Superintendent Ogur tipped me off about the RATAVA organisation.

ANNA:

Second: Ratava is a gang of time terrorists. And the woman in Red, she was on my tail and Ogur tried to help me.

FLASHBACK:

Halt, oder ich schieße. Nein ... No ...

ANNA:

She gunned him down! He too asked me to remember a date.

FLASHBACK:

Am Abend des 9. November ... Erinnern Sie sich, Anna?

ANNA:

Third: A new date: November the 9th.

ANNA:

Fourth: Folge der Musik.

FLASHBACK:

Hör mal!! "Nostalgie" von Friedrich August Dachfeg.

ANNA:

The music I'm following up is called "Nostalgie" ... it's got something to do with the past. And this tune also seems to be incredibly important for the woman in red.

FLASHBACK:

Die Spieldose, Herr Winkler, wenn ich bitten darf! Oder ... Nein, nicht meinen Bruder!

ANNA:

Fifth: Heidrun Drei is Paul's sister.

COMPUTER:

Back up completed. Well done!

DECODAGE 2

SPIELER:

Yeah, got it: You don't remember but I know which November 9th Ogar was on about!

ANNA:

Well, what is it?

SPIELER:

It's from 1989 ... when the Berlin Wall came down!

ANNA:

Well, so what's the 13th of August, 1961 all about then?

SPIELER:

Construction started on the wall. The wall which cut up Berlin for 28 years ...

ANNA:

That's the division ... mentioned in the message on the mirror?

SPIELER:

In der Teilung liegt die Lösung!

ANNA:

That's it. Division is the solution ... There must be a link between the dates and the song "Nostalgie", But what is it? If only I could travel back in time ...

SPIELER:

Travel in time?

CONCLUSION

COMPUTER:

Round ten completed. You've got one life and 60 minutes left. Prepare for level three. You're making progress. But can you travel through time? Do you want to play? Do you want to play?
