Intro:

Maybe you can catch the eye of a cute nurse at the health center.

13. Jimmy: Well, last time I went there I only got to talk to a male nurse.

You can't convince me to go back by talking about cute nurses!

14.SFX: Bicycle bell rings from a distance

15. Hassan: Look at Simo and Steve. What a surprise. Goodness, they

are carrying a chicken -- whose chicken is that?

16. Steve: (coming from a distance) Do you really want to know,

Hassan?

17. Hassan: No, Steve, better spare me the details.

18. Steve: (On mic) Good boy! Hi Jimmy, how are you feeling?

19. Jimmy: Well, what can I say? I feel like I've never felt before -- I

just want to go home! Did you get my money.

20. Steve: Almost, still trying...

21. Manuel: Steve, please could you give Jimmy his money or at

least take him to the nearest health centre. Do

something for goodness' sake!

22. Steve: Manuel, we really love Jimmy and care for him so don't

make it look like you are the only person who loves him

here!

24. Steve: Come on, Manuel, we are all making sacrifices here

and there -- look at this chicken, a friend of mine just gave it to me for free and as a matter of fact I have decided to sell it so I can get some money to pay back

Jimmy's stuff.

25. Hassan: Eh Steve, let's just cook it for Jimmy as he has not had

a healthy meal or a good hot soup in a while.

26.Simo: I'm getting confused here -- are we looking for money

to get treatment or for food?

27.Manuel: Both!

28. Steve: In that case then, that chicken is not enough -- perhaps

just for a traditional healer!

29. Jimmy: Guys, I really don't want to be a burden in your lives. If

my parents found out you had asked a traditional healer about my health they would get mad at me -- they don't

believe in that stuff at all.

30. Hassan: So let's cook the chicken I am sure your parents will be

happy if they hear that your roommates cooked some

chicken for you.

31.Simo: Hassan, isn't this chicken really too big for a patient

without an appetite?

32. Hassan: Oh come on Simo, don't be naïve -- we're going to treat

ourselves too (laughs) and as for the medication, you

and Steve should go and get some pills from a

pharmacy.

the money for a doctor.

can digest food that is too heavy right now.

Did you know? Treating sick people

The facts

A lot of people say a sick person shouldn't drink, but the truth is all patients should drink as much as possible BUT not alcohol, coffee or black tea. Water is the best liquid and it is essential to drink as much of it as possible to recover from illness. This is especially true in warm and humid climates.

The fluids

Two liters of day are recommended. If you have diarrhea for example it is crucial to drink lots of water to avoid dehydration. The same is true if you have a fever and are sweating a lot and losing a lot of liquid. Water is imperative. *However*, it is also crucial to make sure the water is not contaminated. Boil water for at least ten minutes to avoid water-borne diseases such as typhoid.

The foodstuffs

If you are sick, you should get as many vitamins as possible. They can give the body strength to fight the disease. The best way of getting vitamins is from fresh vegetables and fruit. However, if they do not have a peel, make sure they have been washed in clean water. A sick person is more vulnerable to food-borne disease, such as typhoid. A body already weakened by disease might not be able to fight it.

Cleanliness

To speed up the healing process, a sick person needs clean and hygienic surroundings. Clothes and bedclothes should be changed as often as possible. Otherwise, bacteria and viruses might cause a re-

infection. Sick people should also wash as much as possible to get rid of

germs sticking to their bodies.

Sleeping and Resting

The best thing to do if you are ill is to stay in bed -- this is not a sign of laziness. Illness weakens the body so it should get a lot of rest. Don't go to school or work if you are ill but stay in bed until you are better.
