Meryem goes to Duisburg's Comenius secondary school, labeled a "high-risk school" by city officials. Almost all Meryem's schoolmates have an immigrant background. Many of them are just starting to learn German in school. "By the 5th grade, there were only two of us Germans left in the class", says Meryem, "the rest were foreigners, that is Turks and Arabs." The 350 boys and girls can look forward to a less-than-ideal start in life. Whether in class or in the schoolyard, language isn't their only problem. Headmistress Monika Rennings says most of them bring their problems with them to school from home, whether consciously or not.

Die meisten lernen erst in der Schule Deutsch. "In der 5. Klasse waren wir halt nur noch zwei Deutsche in der Klasse. Die restlichen waren Ausländer, also Türken und Araber," sagt Meryem. Die 350 Mädchen und Jungen erwartet ein schlechter Start im Leben, denn das Problem ist nicht nur die Sprache, ob auf dem Schulhof oder im Unterricht. Die meisten – so Schulleiterin Monika Rennings – bringen ihre Probleme auch noch von zu Hause mit.

Brother Lothar's Lonely Battle against Child Slavery**

There are indications that the slave trade is flourishing in Africa. In Sierra Leone, one of the poorest countries in the world, the human traffickers are becoming increasingly bold. Children are seized from indigent parents under a lame pretext. Street children are kidnapped in broad daylight.

The girls generally end up as domestic servants or are forced into prostitution. The boys are put to work in the fields or made to toil in the mines in the north of the country, where gold and blood diamonds are produced.

A young member of the Salesian Order, Brother Lothar Wagner, who came to Sierra Leone from Germany two years ago, runs a centre for street children in the capital Freetown. He is determined to fight child slavery. When youngsters from his centre began disappearing without trace, he built up a network of informers, appealed to the public, and set up shelters at strategic points throughout the city – houses of refuge for children. As a result, he has repeatedly received threats to his life.

This film documents how Brother Lothar traces children who were kidnapped from the hospitals when they were still infants. He searches for them on plantations and in factories, where they are forced to work. He discovers them at secret collection points in the city and at the smugglers' moorings in the port of Freetown. He goes into orphanages and prisons, and even ventures into the notorious diamond mines in northern Sierra Leone.

Bruder Lothars einsamer Kampf gegen Kinderhandel**

Die Meldungen über organisierten Menschenhandel in Afrika häufen sich. In Sierra Leone, einem der ärmsten Länder der Erde, gehen Menschenhändler immer dreister vor: Die Kinder werden armen Eltern unter einem Vorwand abgeschwätzt. Herumstreunende Kinder werden auf offener Straße gekidnappt.

Die verschleppten oder verkauften Mädchen enden als Haussklaven, wenn sie nicht zur Prostitution gezwungen werden. Die Jungen erleiden ein Schicksal entweder als Leibeigene auf den Feldern oder als Bergarbeiter in den Minen im Norden des Landes, wo sie nach Gold und Blutdiamanten schürfen müssen.

Vor zwei Jahren zog ein junger Ordensmann die Alarmglocke. Lothar Wagner, Salesianerbruder aus Trier, leitet in der Hauptstadt Freetown ein Zentrum für Straßenkinder. Er will den Menschenhändlern das Feld nicht kampflos überlassen. Als er bemerkt, dass etliche seiner Zöglinge spurlos verschwinden, baut er ein Netzwerk von Informanten auf,

alarmiert die Öffentlichkeit und richtet an neuralgischen Stellen der Stadt so genannte Shelter ein – Zufluchtsorte für Kinder. Dafür wird er wiederholt mit dem Tode bedroht.

Der Film begleitet ihn, wie er die Spur verschleppter Kinder in den Krankenhäusern aufnimmt, aus denen manche schon als Säuglinge entführt wurden. Wagner sucht sie auf Plantagen und in Fabriken, wo sie als Sklaven arbeiten, spürt sie an geheimen Sammelstellen in der Stadt oder an den Anlageplätzen der Schmuggler im Hafen auf. Er geht in Heime und Gefängnisse und wagt sich selbst in die berüchtigten Diamantenminen im Norden des Landes.

Photographs of an illuminated Brandenburg Gate or a lit up Reichstag go around the world. Light designers are turning Berlin into a nocturnal stage. The Nazis used light for their propaganda. During the war, searchlights combed the night sky. After 1945, light became a political, Cold War issue in the divided city. East Germany's Communist regime wanted to turn Stalinallee – a wide East Berlin boulevard – into Berlin's brightest street. Today, people worry about the energy consumption of public lighting. "Intelligent light" that switches itself off when it's not in use could help protect the environment.
