MUSIC: THEME MUSIC

01. NARRATOR HELLO AND WELCOME TO THIS "LEARNING BY EAR" SERIES WHICH IS ABOUT HYGIENE AND DIARRHOEA. DIARRHOEA IS VERY COMMON IN AFRICA AND A MAJOR KILLER. IN THIS FIRST EPISODE WE MEET SAM AND HIS FAMILY: HIS SIX MONTH OLD BABY SISTER AND HIS MOTHER EDITH. BUT THEY HAVE AN UNWANTED RESIDENT – DIARRHOEA. WE ALSO MEET CHEMU, WHO IS SAM'S GREATEST ADMIRER AND MARIA, THE KNOW-IT-ALL NEIGHBOUR, AND CHEMU'S MOTHER.

> LISTEN ON TO HOW SAM, HIS FAMILY AND FRIENDS STRUGGLE WITH DIARRHOEA AND LEARN ABOUT ITS CAUSES, PREVENTION AND CURE.

SCENE 1: SAM'S SCHOOL'S ATHLETICS FIELD.

02. SFX: BACKGROUND CHEERING BY STUDENTS. FEET RUNNING.

03. EDITH Come on.. SAM, run, run... run son.. run...

- 04. CHEMU(screaming at high pitch) SAMu...! SAMu...!SAMu...
- 05. EDITH/CHEMU/MARIA SAMmu... SAMmu... SAMmu...

06. EDITH(Excited) That is my son.. Everyone, Maria,
Chemu.. look...my son SAM is winning....

07. CHEMU Ooooh... he is so cute!

- **08. MARIA** Chemu, hold your tongue, my daughter, you are too young to fancy boys.
- 09. EDITH Not even my son... ? I thought we were good friends, Maria! SAMu... SAMu... oh no no... nooooo
- **10. CHEMU** (horrified) Sam, what are you doing?
- **11. MARIA**Well, there he goes... that did not last long!You see Chemu, he is no good...the boy can
not....

12. EDITH	Look Maria he has veered off into your farm. What is going on?
13. MARIA	That boy of yours is weird, Edith. Who rushes off into the bush when they are about to win an important race?
14. CHEMU	(sad) What happened to Sam?
15. MARIA	Since you are so worried about your friend, make yourself useful and go find out why he's suddenly gone crazy. Go on We don't have all day!
16. NARRATOR	IF YOU COULD HAVE SEEN SAM A MONTH AGO, YOU WOULD HAVE KNOWN THAT WINNING THIS RACE WAS GOING TO BE A PIECE OF CAKE! BUT IN THE LAST COUPLE OF WEEKS, HE HAS BEEN GROWING WEAKER AND WEAKER. WHAT COULD BE HAPPENING TO HIM? LET'S JOIN CHEMU IN THE BUSH AND FIND OUT.

SCENE 2: IN THE BUSH – MARIA'S FARM

17. SFX: Birds, Crickets

18.	SAM:	(from some distance) SIGHS OF PAIN AND FORCED BREATH
19.	CHEMU	(worried) Sam? Sam? Where are you. Sam?
20.	SAM	(closer) SOUNDS OF SIGHS OF PAIN AND FORCED BREATH
21.	SFX: Liquid spla	shing on ground
22.	CHEMU	SAM Saaaam ? Stop playing this game at once.
23.	SAM	(strained voice) I'm I'm here. But don't come! Keep away!
24.	CHEMU	Come out of there. Why did you stop running? Everyone is worried.
25.	SAM	(painfully) Don't come near me. Go away. Go away now!
26.	CHEMU	Why did you stop running?
27.	SAM	I did not stop running. I am running.
28.	CHEMU	Stop being silly, you stopped running. You ran off the track and into the bush. Get out of there right now!

29. SAM	I can't. My feet stopped running because my stomach started running. Don't come any closer!
30. CHEMU	Eeeeeekkkk What is that smell? Has something died?
31. SAM	(a bit sarcastic) I am just spreading manure on your mother's garden.
32. CHEMU	(Kidding, but also disgusted) SAMmmuuuu you have that diarrhoea again!
MUSIC BRIDGE	
33. NARRATOR	OH MY, OUR SAM IS IN TROUBLE. HOW EMBARRASSING FOR SAM TO BE FOUND IN THIS COMPROMISING SITUATION BY THE VERY GIRL HE WANTS TO IMPRESS. POOR SAM! ONE ALSO WONDERS, HOW HE GOT INFECTED? AND ARE THERE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY SIMILARLY AFFECTED? LET US JOIN SAM AT HOME AND FIND OUT MORE.

SCENE 3: EDITH'S HOME

34. SFX: INTERMITTENT NOISES OF A BABY CRYING

- 35. EDITH (anguished) Ooh no, what do I do now?Maria, tell me. My baby is passing liquid stool.What has happened to my family?
- 36. MARIA Edith, I told you many times before. Make a really thick porridge for Baby Fatu. The porridge will hold the baby's intestine together and make the fluid thicker. I will go and make thick porridge that falls not pours out of the pot. That should fix the diarrhoea. Meanwhile, tell that son of yours to stop defecating in my garden!

37. SFX: DOOR SLAMS: BABY FATU CRIES EVEN MORE

- **38. EDITH**Sam, please come and help with the baby.Here, hold the baby while I....
- **39. SAM** (screams with disgust) AAAHHH! Look what Baby Fatu has done, she has soiled my hands and shirt.
- **40. EDITH** She is your sister. A little dirt from her won't hurt, and it is not the first time this has happened to you. Here is a cloth, wipe yourself dry and throw it in that corner.

BRIDGE MUSIC

41. NARRATOR WELL, DIARRHOEA SEEMS TO REIGN IN THIS HOME! IT'S ALL OVER THEIR BODIES, CLOTHES .. AND MORE IS COMING OUT OF THEM! AND THEY ARE IN THE KITCHEN. THIS CAN'T BE GOOD. COULD THIS BE WHY THE DIARRHOEA IS SPREADING? THE ENTIRE FAMILY COULD UNKNOWINGLY BE INFECTING EACH OTHER AND THOSE NEAR THEM. BUT WHAT ABOUT BABY FATU? SHE DEFINITELY SEEMS VERY SICK.

SCENE 4: EDITH'S HOME

42. SFX: Door opening and slamming, intermittent baby cries

43. MARIA	Chemu, put that porridge over there.
	(exclaiming) Sam, why are you holding the
	baby like she is a bunch of bananas? Here,
	give her to me so I can feed her this porridge.
44. CHEMU	Mother, I am telling you, it is not thick porridge Baby Fatu needs, she needs a Doctor.
45. MARIA	What does my 15-year-old know about running stomachs! The Baby, Sam?

46. SFX: Wet drip/drop

47.	SAM	(hasty) Careful she has nooooh too late.
48.	MARIA	(disgust) Now look what you have done. Now the smell is worse than the City cesspit!
49.	EDITH	My grandmother always said when a baby does that to you, it is a blessing.
50.	MARIA	Mine used holy water, not baby excreta. Chemu, are you going to pass over that porridge or not?
51.	CHEMU	STOP!
52.	MARIA & EDITH	What?
53.	CHEMU	Wash your hands!
54.	MARIA	Why? I have not been handling charcoal
55.	EDITH	Chemu, you think we have so much water to waste, washing hands every now and again?
56.	CHEMU	Baby Fatu has diarrhoea and the teacher said we must always wash our hands to protect ourselves.

57. MARIA Shut up, girl. This is only a baby not a poisonous chemical factory. Are we going to feed her or not?

58. SFX: Chair being pushed

- **59. EDITH** (in surprise) Now what?
- **60. SAM** (in urgency) I have to go. (Runs to the door)
- 61. SFX: Door being opened and slammed
- **62. CHEMU** It's his stomach, it's running again.
- 63. MARIA Then we need more thick porridge for him as well. Chemu, go to our house and make some more.
- 64. CHEMU I think they both need to go to hospital. Teacher said.....
- 65. MARIA (Angry) Shut up. Teacher this, teacher that. That boy is lazy. Have you noticed how he just sits and does nothing these days. He does not even want to run anymore.
- 66. EDITH Maria, you are my friend but I think you are very mean towards my son. Give him a break. Be thankful. Has he not, for the last two weeks, spread free manure on your land?

- 67. MARIA When I want organic fertiliser, I get it from my cow, not from your lazy two-legged son, Edith. 68. EDITH It's free. 69. MARIA It is smelly and it's all over my vegetables. I don't see what my Chemu sees in him. Anyway, young girl, I prohibit you from spending time with a boy who cannot control his bowels. Who knows what else he cannot control! 70. EDITH Maria, are you going to help me with my sick children or are you intent on causing me more grief. 71. SFX: BABY CRYING STOPS AND BABY FALLS ASLEEP 72. MARIA (apologetic). Ah.. sorry Edith, you know me and my big mouth. Ha... Baby Fatu has gone quiet. Is she asleep? But she has not eaten her porridge yet. 73. EDITH She does that. She has diarrhoea, cries, gets
 - exhausted then falls asleep, only to wake up and start crying again. She does not eat well anymore.
- 74. MARIAShe seems to have lost colour too. She
looks... like a dry leaf!

75.	CHEMU	Our teacher told us that dirt brings diarrhoea.
76.	EDITH	(shouting) Girl, what are you saying? That my house is dirty?
77.	MARIA	(Shouting back) Edith, don't you dare yell at my daughter. She is only saying what the teacher said.
78.	CHEMU	Teacher said people suffering from diarrhoea lose all the water that is supposed to stay inside them.
79.	MARIA	Now, now Chemu, when did you become so clever. We can always get some medicine from the local kiosk.
80.	CHEMU	She said anyone who needs to go to the toilet for a hard-call, well, what is supposed to be hard – more than four times a day should see a Doctor immediately
81.	MARIA	Now you are getting on my nerves, girl!
82.	EDITH	Maybe we should get some advice from my brother in-law Eddi and his doctor wife Sally. You know, just to be on the safe side.
83.	MARIA	Aaahh whatever!!

84. NARRATOR INDEED, EDITH'S HOUSEHOLD IS A SAD ONE. HER CHILDREN ARE SICK AND CHEMU, WHO SEEMS TO UNDERSTAND THE GRAVITY OF THE SITUATION IS NOT BEING LISTENED TO. LET'S HOPE THAT EDITH WILL FOLLOW UP ON HER IDEA OF SEEKING ADVICE FROM EDDI AND DR. SALLY. BUT WILL SHE FOLLOW THROUGH AND WILL EDDI AND DR SALLY ARRIVE IN TIME FROM THE CITY?
