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SCENE 1: HOSPITAL TRIAGE UNIT

02. SFX: BABY CRIES, BACKGROUND SIRENS, HOSPITAL

NOISES ETC. AND FAR AWAY SOUNDS OF

AMBULANCE AND CRACKING

INTERCOMS

o3. EDITH

(silently crying) I nearly killed my baby... I

can not lose another member of my family,

first Baba Sam now my baby.... .Eddi, what do

I do now?... What are they doing to my baby?

O4. EDDI Edith, please calm down, they are running some tests.

05. EDITH What tests? Why don't they just give her some medicine and let me take her home?

Of. EDDI

They have to find out which types of parasites or bacteria have infected her. Then they will be able to prescribe the right medication for her.

O7. EDITH You mean, Maria's ash bananas were not going to heal her?

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08. EDDIBaby Fatu should have been here in hospital

within seven days of suspecting diarrhoea.

Diarrhoea is a serious business, you should

not trust home remedies. Those ash bananas

might be a good home remedy for other

things, but definitely not for this type of

diarrhoea.

09. EDITH But my friend Maria was so sure and

determined. She kept trying one remedy after

another. Ooh, my child. Chemu, I know your

mother intentions were good.

10. CHEMU God help the baby.

11. EDDI The Doctors must also check how much

damage has been done to her body by the

germs.

12. EDITH My poor child. I'm such a bad mother.

13. EDDI Sshhhh don't say that. You are a good mother,

you just did not know enough about diarrhoea

to protect your children.

14. EDITH But, but.. where did these germs come from? I

do not keep any at home.

15. EDDI (chuckles sadly) They are everywhere.

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16. CHEMU They are on our hands. Our teacher said when

you do not wash your hands you can get diarrhoea. Edith, I told you we should wash

our hands and you refused...

17. EDDIE Chemu, not now... not now... I think they are

ready for us. Let's go see the doctors. We are

lucky my wife is on duty today.

BRIDGE MUSIC

SCENE 2: DR SALLY'S OFFICE

18. SFX: FOOTSTEPS APPROACHING.

19. EDITH Dr. Sally, Dr Sally please tell me my baby will

be ok. Please. She will be ok, won't she?

20. DR. SALLY Baby Fatu is receiving medical attention but...

I must say, she does not look good. She is not

good at all. Why did you not bring her to

hospital earlier?

21. CHEMU Auntie Sally, they wouldn't listen to me. I told

them that teacher said.....

22. EDDI Not now Chemu... not now. Let's hear what

Dr. Sally has to say.

23. DR SALLY Well, Baby Fatu is very dehydrated. We have

taken her to the Intensive Care Unit.

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24. EDITH Oh, good heavens. I want to see her. I want to

see her now!

BRIDGE MUSIC

SCENE 3: PAEDIATRICS ICU

25. SFX: BABY CRIES. ICU MACHINES BEEPS

26. EDDI She is over there, the cot in the corner.

27. EDITH Oh dear Lord, what have they done to her?

What have I done? She has tubes in her

like....What are they doing to her?

28. EDDI Sssshhhh don't panic. They have put her on

intravenous drugs and fluids.

29. EDITH (**crying**) Eddi, I want my Baby. I want her to

get well. I want to hold her... please, please..

let's take her home. I promise I will take good

care of her. I promise.

30. EDDI (**firmly**) The best place for this child now, is

right here, here in the hospital.

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31. NARRATOR SO, EDITH TOOK HER PLACE NEXT TO

THE BABY'S COT AND TRIED TO KEEP

HER HOPES UP. MEANWHILE, IN THE

WAITING ROOM, CHEMU TOOK HER

CHANCE TO ASK ABOUT WHAT SHE SAW

IN THE PEDIATRICS UNIT.

SCENE 4: HOSPITAL WAITING ROOM

32. SFX: FAR AWAY SOUNDS OF AMBULANCE AND INTERCOMS

33. CHEMU Auntie Sally, have Uncle Eddi and Fatu's Mum

gone to see Baby Fatu?

34. DR SALLY Yes, they have. But she is very sick. You can

see her later, not now.

35. CHEMU Aunty Sally?

36. DR SALLY Yes, Chemu?

37. CHEMU I heard them saying she was on a drip. What

is a drip?

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38. DR SALLY

Chemu, sometimes when we get very sick, like when we get diarrhoea, we lose most of the fluid from our bodies. You see, a large part of our body is made up of fluids or water. So, if we lose most of it, our body cannot function properly. It's like a car without petrol or oil. We must help the body replace the lost fluid, so the doctors have put a tube with fluid into the baby.

39. CHEMU

But, why don't you just give her cups of water?

40. DR SALLY

It's not just plain water Baby Fatu is getting from the drip. The fluid has medicines and nourishment. Did you notice that Baby Fatu was not only passing stool a lot but was also not eating well?

41. CHEMU

Oh, she just cried, *pow-powed*, slept, woke up, cried and *pow-powed* some more.

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42. DR SALLY So you see, she needs food as well. She

needs strength and nutrients as well as stuff to

kill the parasites and bacteria in her body.

Since the food does not stay long in her body,

we have to find a way in which the food can

remain long enough for the body to take in the

nutrients. She is therefore given these in the

tubes which go directly into the blood.

43. CHEMU Auntie Sally, you are so clever, I want to be a

Doctor like you. I want to....

44. SFX: A RUSH OF FOOTSTEPS TOWARDS THEM

45. EDITH (Crying loudly) SALLY..... Sally... Sally...

come... come quickly.... My baby... my baby

is dying, come... come...

46. CHEMU What ... what is happening?

47. EDDI Sally, honey, this way quick... quick ..it's Baby

Fatu. Its bad.. very bad.

48. SFX: INTERCOM CRACKS TO LIFE.

49. HOSPITAL ANNOUNCER/INTERCOM DR SALLY

MWANKA... DR SALLY MWANKA... please

report to the Peadiatrics Ward. Dr. Sally for the

Peadiatrics Ward.

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50. SFX. MANY FOOTSTEPS RUSH AWAY

BRIDGE MUSIC OF SAD NATURE

51. NARRATOR DIARRHOEA HAS TAKEN AWAY YET

ANOTHER CHILD OF AFRICA. BABY FATU

HAS JOINED THE STATISTICS OF THE

MANY CHILDREN THAT DIE DUE TO

DIARRHOEA, A MAJOR KILLER IN AFRICA.

A SICKNESS, THOUGH, THAT COULD

HAVE BEEN AVOIDED.

SCENE 5: DR SALLY'S OFFICE

52. CHEMU (**Crying**) Baby Fatu is dead.... It can't be.

53. EDITH (whimpering) It's me, it's my fault. I should

have acted earlier. Now I have brought death

to my family again.

54. EDDI There ... there, now, my sister. Take heart.

What God gives, he also takes.

55. CHEMU (sniffling) ... that is not fair. He gives, he

takes and he gives diarrhoea. Why did he not

take diarrhoea away and leave Baby Fatu with

us? (cries).

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56. DR SALLY Edith, I wish there is something I could do. We

tried our best. It was just too late. I wish I had

known about Baby Fatu's illness earlier.

57. CHEMU (angry) It is not fair... not fair....

58. DR SALLY I should have visited you more often. Then I

would have....

59. EDDI Sally, please don't blame yourself. I am the

one who should have visited them more often.

She is my brother's widow. I am supposed to

take care of them. I should have been closer

to them..

60. CHEMU (screams suddenly) Ooh no.. I'm going to

die, Auntie Sally, I'm dying.. I'm dying ...

please help.

61. EDDI Stop it, stop! Chemu

62. DR SALLY (alarmed) Chemu, why do you think you are

dying?

63. CHEMU I touched Baby Fatu. I didn't wash my hands.

Teacher said.....(stops)

64. DR SALLY Teacher said what?

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65. CHEMU It's in the song:

(rapping) Wash your hands.

Only washed hands should be used,

to eat.

Careless people

Don't wash their hands after visiting the toilet.

Keep healthy. Wash your hands.

66. DR SALLY Look here, Chemu. That's a good song. You

should teach it to all the children. Now, go and

use that sink and wash your hands. You are

not dying. I am here. I am your Auntie and

Doctor. Ok?

67. EDITH (wailing) My baby is gone, my baby is gone...

68. CHEMU (in shock) Sam!!!!

69. EDDI Now what? What about Sam?

70. CHEMU Sam!!! Sam!!!.....he's dying... He is going to

die! Oh no... Sam!!.. No, not Sam....

71. DR SALLY (interrupts) Chemu... what do you mean..?

What ... where is Sam?

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72. EDITH (wailing) No.... no... not my Sam as well...

now everyone is dead... God take me as

well... give me this diarrhoea and let me join

my children. Baba Sam... I am coming

now...(wails more).

73. EDDI Chemu, ... tell us, what about Sam, where is

he? What is wrong with him?

74. CHEMU Sam.. Sam..dying... in bed... at home..

diarrhoea is killing him, too.

75. DR SALLY Oh no. Eddi, get the car, let's go.

76. EDITH (wailing)... Oooiiii... oiiiiii, the devil has visited

my home again. Diarrhoea, you are the devil...

devil go away, go away. Diarrhoea you

devil.... You killer.....

77. DR SALLY Come... come on Edith... Let's go get Sam.

78. EDITH I won't leave Baby Fatu... but I need Sam... I

can't go...ooh what shall I do now (cries).

79. DR SALLY Fatu is in good hands. The hospital will take

care of her.. her body. We must now go and

save Sam. Let's go... let's... go....Please

Edith. We have to go and get Sam before it

too late...

80. NARRATOR

POOR EDITH. THINGS ARE VERY BAD FOR HER AT THE MOMENT, BUT SHE NOW HAS TO WORRY ABOUT THE LIVING AND LEAVE THE HOSPITAL STAFF TO DEAL WITH HER POOR DEAD BABY. SAM MUST BE SAVED. AFRICA HAS LOST A CHILD IN BABY FATU, BUT AFRICA MUST NOT LOSE THE TEENAGER AS WELL. THEY MUST GET SAM TO MEDICAL HELP QUICKLY.
