MUSIC: THEME MUSIC

01. NARRATOR

HELLO AND WELCOME TO EPISODE FOUR OF OUR "LEARNING BY EAR" SERIES CALLED "HYGIENE - HOW TO AVOID DIARRHOEA". IN THE LAST EPISODE BABY FATU LOST HER LIFE TO DIARRHOEA. BUT THEY LEFT THE HOSPITAL IN A RUSH BECAUSE THEY NEEDED TO CHECK ON SAM WHO HAD BEEN LEFT AT HOME, IN BED. THERE MUST BE A WAY TO SAVE SAM FROM DIARRHOEA AND ITS CONSEQUENCES. LET'S LISTEN WHAT HAPPENS WHEN THEY GET TO THE HOUSE WHERE THEIR NEIGHBOUR, MARIA, IS WAITING FOR THEM...

SCENE 1: EDITH'S HOME

02. SFX: A CAR DRIVES IN. SCREECHES TO A STOP. CAR

DOORS OPEN. CAR DOORS BANG SHUT.

FOOTSTEPS. DOOR OPENS AND IS

SLAMMED SHUT

03. MARIA (angry) Edith! And you, my daughter Chemu!
What took you so long? I have been stuck
here alone with Sam.

04. CHEMU (calling out) Sam, Sam..

05. MARIA (agitated) Chemu.. what is wrong with you, child? ...And you, Eddi and your Doctor wife Sally ... why is everyone wearing such long faces?

06. CHEMU (distraught) Samu samu, Mother, Sam is dying... don't die Sam, oooh where are you?

O7. MARIA (angry) Chemu... ..Stop! Where are your manners? Stop pushing everyone out of your way! And where are you going anyway?

08. EDITH (crying) Ooh.. everyone is dead now...

Diarrhoea - come take me as well!!!

09. SFX: CHAIR SQUEAKS AND SOMEONE DRAGS IT ALONG A HARD SURFACE.

10. MARIA Edith, could someone tell me what is going

on? And where is Baby Fatu? Asleep in the

car? You know all she does is cry and sleep

11. DR SALLY (interrupts, soberly) Maria, Baby Fatu is

dead!

12. MARIA What..? Dr. Sally, what are you saying? That's

not possible... Ooh my friend Edith... I am so

sorry... I didn't know ... You should have all

told me immediately... oh no... I should have

baked those bananas earlier... they sure

would have helped. And now, Baby Fatu has

.

13. DR SALLY Don't blame yourself Maria and there is no

way those bananas would have helped.

14. EDITH (**crying**) What do we do now?

15. NARRATOR AS EVERYBODY ELSE WAS THINKING

ABOUT POOR BABY FATU, CHEMU

FINALLY MADE IT INTO SAM'S BEDROOM

AND PALE AS HE LOOKED, SHE WASN'T

SURE HE WAS STILL ALIVE...

SCENE 2: SAM'S BEDROOM

16. SFX: SOUNDS OF BED CREAKING, RUSTLE OF CLOTHES

17. CHEMU Sam... Sammuuu... are you dead? Are you

dead?

18. SAM (very weak) Yes, Chemu, I am dead. The way

I feel, I could as well be dead.....

19. CHEMU Don't die, Sam, don't die... Get up....get up....

we have to go to hospital. If we don't,

diarrhoea will kill you, just like Baby Fatu

20. SAM (very weak) What... is my sister dead? Oh

no...

21. SFX: DOOR OPENS. FOOTSTEPS APPROACH

22. DR SALLY Sam... Are you awake? Get up, I've come to

take you to hospital. PAUSE (softly to

herself) Oh no, this room smells.

23. SAM (very weak) Then, it is true, about Fatu,

Auntie Sally?

24. DR SALLY Yes, Sam, I'm very sorry, but the most

important thing right now is to get you to

hospital... NOW!!!

25. CHEMU He is trying to get up. He can't... He is too

weak.. His legs can't carry him.

26. SAM (**crying softly**) I don't believe it about Fatu. Dr

Sally, will I also die? I have diarrhoea, don't I?

And that may kill me.. Isn't that right?

27. DR SALLY If you do not get medical attention

immediately, you have a high chance of dying.

How long have you been sick? When did you

first notice you were going to the toilet too

often?

28. SAM I don't know... about ... about two weeks

ago...

29. DR SALLY That is too long! You should have gone to

hospital sooner. Now, come on, let me help

you. Diarrhoea is very dangerous, especially

when it just carries on. We must go to hospital

at once.

30. CHEMU Sam, you did not wash your hands. That is

why you are sick.. I sang you my hand-

washing song..... I must teach it to you...

31. DR SALLY Not now Chemu.. let's help him get dressed

and then we'll go to hospital...

32. SFX: DOOR OPENS, QUICK FOOTSTEPS APPROACH.

33. MARIA (disgust) Eeegghhh, this place smells like ...

like.. a sewer.

34. DR SALLY Oh Maria, it's good you are here. Help me get

Sam ready. He is too weak to even walk, let

alone dress himself.

35. MARIA Don't ask me to touch this boy. The whole day,

after you left me alone with him, this boy has

been like two busy jets. Watery and smelly

stuff has been gushing out from both ends. We

just didn't know which end would be next.

Look at this clothes, see...

36. SFX: RUSTLE OF CLOTHES

37. DR SALLY (urgently) STOP!!! STOP Maria, do not touch

his soiled clothes with your bare hands.

Now.... Go out.. out, out, now Maria and wash

your hands immediately.

38. MARIA What is wrong with my hands? I have nursed

many other sick people! This is no different.

39. CHEMU Teacher said we must wash our hands all the

time....

40. MARIA (interrupting) Young lady, I keep telling you,

you are not....

41. DR SALLY

(firmly) Maria, I am the Doctor here, and I am asking you to go and wash your hands thoroughly, right now. Otherwise, you too will be the next who .. how did you describe it? "Doesn't know which end will be next." Well, if you do not wash your hands immediately, you will be also be spraying from both end in a matter of hours. It is exactly by handling clothes contaminated with excreta like this, that you are passing on diarrhoea to each other! Now Maria, go wash your hands.

42. CHEMU (softly raps)

Wash your hands.
Only washed hands should be used, to eat.
Careless people,
Don't wash their hands after visiting the toilet.
Keep healthy.
Wash your hands.

43. SFX: FOOTSTEPS AWAY. DOOR SLAMS LOUDLY AS CHEMU SINGS

44. NARRATOR AS THEY HELP SAM UP OUT OF THE BED

AND TO THE HOSPITAL, CHEMU SINGS

ON, REMINDING HERSELF AND

EVERYONE WHO WILL LISTEN THAT THE

SIMPLE ACTION OF WASHING HANDS

WILL KEEP DIARRHOEA AWAY. AS WILL

AVOIDING TOUCHING SURFACES

CONTAMINATED BY EXCRETA.

IT WAS SAD TO LOSE BABY FATU, BUT IT

LOOKS LIKE AFRICA WILL NOT LOSE

ANOTHER CHILD IN SAM, THAT IS, IF THEY

GET TO HOSPITAL IN TIME.

SCENE 3: HOSPITAL WARD

45. SFX: HOSPITAL NOISES AND FAR AWAY SOUNDS OF INTERCOMS.

46. CHEMU Sam, they have put you on a drip like they did

Baby Fatu... but it did not help her....

47. SAM Dr Sally, thanks for bringing me to hospital but

I am really scared. I am scared that I will die

like my baby sister, Fatu.

48. CHEMU Sam, if you die, I will die....

49. DR SALLY Shhh, no one is dying. Actually no one needs

to die of diarrhoea. You and I can prevent it and if unluckily you do get it, if you are treated

early enough, you will recover. It is as simple

as that.

50. CHEMU I know, Auntie Sally, I know....

51. DR SALLY You must tell all your parents, friends

everyone: it is simple to avoid and to

treat....OK?

52. SAM/CHEMU Yes, Auntie Sally.

53. SAM What are they doing with all the samples they

took from me?

54. CHEMU (cheekily) You had to put your poo and pee in

a small bottle! Ha ha ha!

55. SAM (**embarrassed**) Aaaahlll Stop her, Auntie

Sally.

56. DR SALLY (**bemused**) Come on Chemu, give your

boyfriend a break.

SAM AND CHEMU TOGETHER:

57. SAM (angry) She is not my girlfriend!!!!

58. CHEMU (angry) He is not my boyfriend!!!

59. DR SALLY (amused) Glad we got that important fact out

of the way... Can we now go back to your illness, Sam? You see Sam, I looked at your

stool sample...

60. CHEMU Yuuuk!

61. DR SALLY (ignoring Chemu) It was watery with traces of

blood and mucus. These are signs of amoebic

infection. We call it amoebiasis.

62. CHEMU Yuuuuuuk!

63. DR SALLY The medical staff here will probably find

protozoa infections like amoebiasis that has

invaded and eaten away the inside of the

intestine. That's what produces the blood and

mucus. We call it dysentery.

64. CHEMU Yuky yuky... dysentery is yuuky

65. DR SALLY (to Chemu) Yes, Chemu, you also get to feel

very yuuky!

66. SAM Is that what killed my baby sister?

67. DR SALLY There are different diarrhoeal bacteria and

parasites. I believe what Baby Fatu had was

Enteropathogenic bacteria.

68. SAM (interrupts) Entertho-what?

69. DR SALLY

(laughing) I am glad you have re-found your sense of humour! The drip fluid and nutrients must be working. Let me try and explain in simple words. What Baby Fatu had was similar to you but slightly different. The bacteria in her produced toxins that eat away the inside of the intestine. They interfere with the body's ability to take up the fluids and nutrients which we get from what we eat and drink.

70. CHEMU

Poor Baby Fatu.

71. DR SALLY

She got dehydrated and lost a lot of body fluid. This, by the way Sam, is the main cause of deaths in children.

72. SAM

She cried a lot.

73. DR SALLY

This is because the dehydration eating away the lining of the intestine causes a lot of pain and discomfort in the stomach and bowels. You have been throwing up a lot, haven't you?

74. SAM

Yes, much more than Baby Fatu.

75. CHEMU

Yuk!

76. DR SALLYWell, this is also because the pain you feel is due to the cramps as a result of intestines

reacting to the bacterial toxins.

77. CHEMU Dr Sally... this is getting hard... bacterial,

amoeba to.. to.. toxins?

78. DR SALLY Oh, I am sorry Chemu. ... actually it is time

we leave Sam alone to rest. He will have to

rest a lot to get well again. .

79. CHEMU (sulking) I want to stay with Sam. Can I stay

here? I want to take care of him....I promise.. I

promise I will be good...

80. DR SALLY (laughing) Chemu, the best care you can now

give Sam is to let him rest and get his strength

back. We will come back and see him

tomorrow.

81. CHEMU (happy) Promise?

82. DR SALLY Promise Chemu, I promise you.

OUTRO:

83. NARRATOR

WELL, FORTUNATELY SAM IS NOW ON THE MEND. THE HOSPITAL STAFF WILL MAKE SURE HE REGAINS HIS HEALTH BY GIVING HIM MEDICATION TO FIGHT THE BACTERIA OR PARASITES THAT IS CAUSING THE DIARRHOEA. THEY ARE ALSO HELPING HIM REGAIN HIS BODY NUTRIENTS AND FLUIDS. SAM WILL SURVIVE.

HOWEVER, BACK AT HOME, WE HAVE STILL NOT IDENTIFIED WHAT CAUSED THE DIARRHOEA IN THE FIRST PLACE. WE ALSO KNOW THERE ARE SOILED CLOTHES LEFT BEHIND BY BABY FATU AND SAM. ARE WE ABOUT TO HAVE ANOTHER CASE OF DIARRHOEA AT EDITH'S HOME?
