02. MUSIC: THEME MUSIC

03. **NARRATOR**

Hello and welcome to Episode **Nine** of our "Learning by Ear" **Girl's Rights** series. In the last episode, the girls had leadership challenges. However, by focusing on leadership qualities and not Gender, Cheptoo managed to be voted in as Head Prefect of the school.

In today's episode, Ciro, Cheptoo and Fatuma debate girls' sexuality. Join them and listen on!

SCENE 1: SCHOOL PLAY GROUND

04. SFX: PLAY GROUND NOISES

05. **CHEPTOO** Ciro, there is Fatuma.. she is heading

this way. Fatu! Fatu! This way.. we are

here

06. **CIRO** Fatuma.. what's with this new walking

style?

07. **FATUMA** (GRUDGINGLY) What walking style?

08. **CHEPTOO** Girl, walk straight! What are you shy of?

Your breasts?

09. CIRO Her breasts are growing and she is self-

conscious and shy about it...Look...

look...

10. **FATUMA** Leave me alone... leave me alone...

11. CHEPTOO Fatuma, I might be just a couple of years

older than you, but let me tell you, girl:

Growing breasts is normal. Fatuma, this

is normal. It is about becoming a woman.

Don't feel shy. Be confident with

yourself.

12. **CIRO** Yes, you should feel proud to be a

woman. Now, look at me. Fatuma, throw

your shoulders back, put your chin up.

13. **FATUMA** Ooh dear me... the boys tease me and

make me self-conscious.

14. **CHEPTOO** They are not teasing you. They too need

to understand this is a natural process.

We all have a lot to learn about our

bodies, don't we?

15. BRIDGE MUSIC

SCENE 2 VILLAGE PATH

16. SFX: FARM NOISES; FOOTSTEPS

17. **CIRO** Cheptoo, I am surprised you offered to

walk me home. Your home is in the

opposite direction.

18. **CHEPTOO** Ciro, you know me too well. There's

something I wanted to talk to you about.

19. **CIRO** What?

20. **CHEPTOO** Nothing much.. well.. it's not easy

21. **CIRO** (LAUGHING) I don't believe Cheptoo

you would ever be uncomfortable about

anything.

22. **CHEPTOO** Well.... It's it's.. your cousin Abdi!

23. **CIRO** What has my naughty cousin done

now...?

24. **CHEPTOO** I... I.. well.. he is not that bad.

25. **CIRO** (SHOCKED) I don't believe .. girl.. you like him.. all that fighting has been all pretence. 26. **CHEPTOO** Shhhh not so loud. We have been talking ... many times You are dating my cousin and you didn't 27. **CIRO** tell me... but you are both too young. 28. **CHEPTOO** We are both 15 years old.. you know...well... it's natural, we kind of like each other. 29. **CIRO** I am in shock: you and Abdi? Is that what you wanted to tell me? 30. **CHEPTOO** There is more... 31. **CIRO** Go on am listening. 32. **CHEPTOO** He wants us to .. you know what.... 33. **CIRO** Do what (SILENCE) you mean that... oh no... you are having sex? 34. **CHEPTOO** Shshhhhh.. I told you, not too loud. I am confused.. I don't know what to do. Do you think we should...

35. **CIRO** I don't know, Cheptoo. But it does not

feel right. Are we ready for this? I'm also confused. It might sound weird, but let's call the 'Girls' Parliament' and debate the

issue.

36. **CHEPTOO** Why not! Let's go to the 'Girls'

Parliament'. But this time it should be

girls only!

37. BRIDGE MUSIC

SCENE 3 PLAYING FIELDS

38. SOUNDS: PLAYGROUND NOISES, GIRLS CHATTERING AND LAUGHING (studio)

39. **CHEPTOO** Girls, girls.. thank you for sparing your

break time for this urgently convened

Girls' Parliament.

40. **CIRO** We have a new debate. It's on sexuality,

our bodies and also...well.. you know... those things we are too shy at times to

discuss with adults.

41. **CHEPTOO** Like sex!

42. **FATUMA** ssshhhh Surely, Cheptoo, do you have

to be so blunt and ..and.. loud.

43. **CHEPTOO** That is the issue, you can't even mention

the word without everyone getting

nervous and uncomfortable. How are we going to learn if we can't even mention

the issue?

44. **CIRO** You have a point, Cheptoo. The purpose

of the 'Girls' Parliament' is to discuss the

issues that affect girls and girls' rights.

Where else will we do this if not here.

45. **GIRLS** Sure sure.. agreed.

46. **CHEPTOO** I will open the debate. Fatuma is shy

about the way her body is developing,

and my question is: well, can I have sex

at my age?

47. **FATUMA** I am still so uncomfortable with this

debate.

48. **CHEPTOO** Would you rather want we did not

discuss the issue and we secretly made

mistakes and suffered lots of confusion?

49. **CIRO** Let's move on, please.

50. **FATUMA** Ok, I agree that I have to accept that my body is growing. Fine, but Cheptoo should not be talking about sex. 51. **CIRO** Why? She only asked a question? 52. **FATUMA** At 15 she is too young to have such relationships. She should wait. 53. **CIRO** Remember what the Biology teacher told us about teenagers and the hormones that are here and there and everywhere. 54. **ALL** LAUGHTER 55. **FATUMA** So, what about Cheptoo and having sex at her age? 56. **CHEPTOO** I think I have my own answer now. I should wait. We are all too young to be .. what do they call it.... sexually active. But we can't ignore that there are changes happening in our bodies. So we must learn more and more about our bodies so we are better prepared. 57. **CIRO** Cheptoo, that is the best thing you have shared with us. We can ask for advice from our teachers. We should not feel shy asking questions.

58. **FATUMA** We should also feel free to talk to our

parents. They know what we are going

through.

59. **CHEPTOO** Ok girl, now I am convinced. I will wait

longer before having sex. But we must hold these talks more often. Now I know I am not alone in this confusion. I am so

glad we had this chat.

60. BRIDGE MUSIC

SCENE 4: CIRO'S CLASSROOM. LUNCH HOUR

61. SFX: classroom

62. **CHEPTOO** Ciro... There you are? We have been

looking for you. We could not start lunch

without you. What are you still doing in

the classroom?

63. **CIRO** Leave me alone. Go away.

64. **FATUMA** What is wrong with you? Why are you

being rude.. we just came looking for

you.

65. **CIRO** Go away.

66. **CHEPTOO** Get up Ciro, I am hungry, let's go and

eat.

67. **CIRO** I said 'go away'.

68. **CHEPTOO** Something is wrong. Isn't it. You don't

want to stand up.

69. **FATUMA** What is wrong, Ciro.

70. **CHEPTOO** I think it's that time of the month. She

has stained her skirt.

71. **CIRO** Go away.. I am so embarrassed. The

boys laughed at me.

72. **CHEPTOO** But this can happen to any woman.. you

should not feel bad about it. Don't feel

bad about this, Ciro. We are women, it is

likely to happen.

73. **FATUMA** I have an idea. Here, wrap this scarf

around you and let's walk to the ladies'

room and clean you up.

74. **CHEPTOO** We have so many challenges and

worries as girls. We should call the 'Girls

Parliament' to discuss the matter.

75. **CIRO** Can you first help me before we call all

the others?

76. BRIDGE MUSIC

77. **NARRATOR** The parliament has been summoned.

Two mature women, Social Worker Janet and Teacher Mona have been invited to share their experience and

their wisdom.

SCENE 5: GIRLS' PARLIAMENT

78. SFX: GIRLS CHATTING (studio)

79. **CHEPTOO** Silence everyone! As you all know, this

time we have invited all the girls to our

Parliament. With guidance from Teacher

Mona and Janet, let's discuss our

bodies. Let's discuss issues about our

bodies that leave us confused.

80. **CIRO** Why don't we ever mention certain parts

of our bodies by their real names?

81. **FATUMA** Because we have been told that they are

bad parts of our bodies.

82. **CHEPTOO** But they can't be bad if they are part of

our bodies.

83. **FATUMA** I can never touch my private parts.

Teacher Mona, is that bad? I have been

told it is bad to touch.

84. **TEACHER MONA** How then, do you clean that part of your

body? Girls, I want you to learn one

thing. There is no part of your body that

is bad. Be proud of all your body. It is

what makes you a woman.

85. **CIRO** When I am in my monthly periods, I feel

dirty. I am also told not to cook food

because I am dirty. Janet, is this correct?

86. **JANET** These are misconceptions that we must

change. If women did not have

menstrual periods, then they would not

be productive, then no children would be

born, and where would that leave the

world? You are not dirty, you are

women. Teacher Mona, do you want to

add to this?

87. **TEACHER MONA** Yes, definitely, you should be proud to

be a woman; however, you must obey

the basic hygiene rules. You must

		change your sanitary wear every few hours at the minimum. You must not give others reason to think you are dirty.
88.	FATUMA	Sometimes others tease us about our bodies. Like when our breasts start to grow.
89.	TEACHER MONA	Ignore those who tease and laugh at you. They do it out of ignorance.
90.	CIRO	Teacher Mona, that is easier said than done. Why don't we also run sessions like these for everyone in the school?
91.	СНЕРТОО	Or sing this song I have been sort of writing and teach it to others.
92.	CIRO	A song?
93.	СНЕРТОО	Yes, I call it the 'Girl Power' song.
94.	JANET	That's interesting. Teach us all.
95.	СНЕРТОО	Here we go, after me. Sing after me.
96.	NARRATOR	And so, a song is crafted. A song that builds the girls' confidence and reminds them to be proud of who they are. Let's see now if all the girls can sing the song Cheptoo composed.

97. **GIRLS** We are girls, we are girls

We are proud to be girls
We are proud of our bodies

At times we get confused with the rapid

changes in our bodies

But we know it is nature taking its

course.

Do not panic, do not panic

Do not shy away, do not shy away It is but nature, making me a beautiful

girl, a beautiful woman

I am like a flower, blossoming

I am a girl, I am beautiful

Who am I, not to be proud of me? We are girls, proud to be girls

100. **CHEPTOO** That is fabulous. Are we not great!? We

must teach all the girls this song.

101. **CIRO/FATUMA** We must!
