#### **INTRO:**

Hello, dear listeners! This is our Learning by Ear radio drama called "The Lost kid – the Story of Single Mothers in Africa". In our last episode, Kassech's brother Jonas and his two teenage friends, made their final plans to rob Mr. Kasu, the richest man in the district. At the same time, Aster and her grandparents found Kassech's little boy, Begidu on a street of the capital as he was looking for some leftovers in a garbage container. Remember, Begidu had run away because his was treating him so badly. Stay tuned to our eighth episode called "Never say never again!" Kassech, who has no idea that her lost kid has been found, is on her way to visit her landlords, Papa Tilahun and Mama Beletu.

## SCENE ONE: DAY AT PAPA TILAHUN'S HOUSE

1. SFX: DAYTIME AMBIANCE FROM OUTSIDE, DOOR KNOCKED

2. Papa Tilahun: Oh! Kassech, come in, the door's open.

3. **Kassech:** Thank you very much, Papa Tilahun.

KW Begin

4. **Papa Tilahun:** How's work?

5. Kassech It's not bad, but I'm sorry I still haven't paid all

of the rent. I'll be able to pay you everything I

owe in the next few days.

6. Papa Tilahun: It's OK, take your time. Why don't you sit

down?

7. Kassech: (Sits on the chair).

**8. SFX: CHAIR BEING PULLED** 

9. Papa Tilahun: You told me last time we talked that you were

planning to start taking evening classes again.

10. **Kassech:** Yes! That's another reason why I haven't been

able to pay the rent on time.

11. **Papa Tilahun:** Don't worry about the rent too much. I

understand your problems.

12. **Kassech:** Thank you very much, Papa Tilahun! When

Mama Beletu told me that you need to talk to

me urgently, I immediately thought it was about

the rent.

13. Papa Tilahun: (Laughs) Do you think that Papa Tilahun only

worries about collecting the rent?

14. **Kassech:** No, no I didn't mean it like that.

**KW End** 

15. Papa Tilahun: Oh, well! (he laughs, and she laughs) Is there

any news of your son, Begidu?

16. Kassech: (Very sadly) Nothing, Papa Tilahun, nothing! I

regret my behaviour so much! Apparently, everything I did was wrong! I thought being strict was the right thing to do. I treated Begidu like that because my mother treated me the same way. And – well – sometimes I don't

know any better.

17.**Papa Tilahun:** You understand now that what you did was

wrong. That is very important. (Calls out)

Aster! (Pause, someone appears).

18. SFX: FOOTSTEP APPROACH

19. **Kassech:** Oh, good afternoon, Mama Beletu.

20. **Mama Beletu:** Good afternoon, Kassech!

21. **Papa Tilahun:** Where's Aster?

22. **Mama Beletu:** She's glued to her mobile phone. **(To Begidu)** 

Come in, my boy.

23. **Begidu:** Mama! (Runs)

24. **Kassech:** (Shocked) Begidu!

25. SFX: SOMEONE FALLS DOWN ON THE GROUND

26. Mama Beletu: (Frantically) Oh, Lord! She's unconscious!

27. **Begidu:** Mama! (Cries)

28. **Papa Tilahun:** Run fast! Bring a glass of water.

29. **Mama Beletu:** Oh, Lord! (Runs to the other room).

30. Papa Tilahun: Kassech, Kassech, Kassech!

31. Begidu: (Cries).

32. **NARRATION:** The surprise was too much for Kassech. She's fainted. Later that same day, in the same neighborhood, Kassech's younger brother Jonas and his friends talk excitedly as they leave a local bar. They're not drunk, but they had a bit to drink, and they are ready to break into the house of Mr. Kasu, the richest man in town.

# **SCENE TWO: NIGHT OUTSIDE THE LOCAL BAR**

33. SFX: WIND IS BLOWING, NIGHT AMBIANCE

34. SFX: THREE PEOPLE WALK ON A GRAVEL ROAD

35. Challa: I don't like that bar, especially when your

drunken neighbor Minabu is there, Jonas.

36. **Jonas:** I don't know why but today he didn't drink as

much as usual. Instead he spent most of his

time staring at us.

37. **Mekete:** Forget that drunkard. Just give me a match.

38. **Challa:** Here it is, sir! **(Fires the match).** 

KW begin

39. SFX: FIRING THE MATCH

**40. Mekete:** Hey! What did you do with the joint??

41. Challa: (Joking) The joint?

42. **Jonas:** Ah, quit joking and hand it over.

43. **Mekete:** Challa! Are you stupid or what? You know, in a

minute we're going to Mr. RICHEST MAN IN

TOWN.

44. **Challa:** OK, OK! Here's your spliff.

45. **Jonas:** Give it to ME!

**46. Mekete:** Nah, I get it first!

47. **Challa:** Cool down, guys. I've got enough for all of us.

48. **Mekete:** All right! Let's sit down here - there's no one

around. (They all sit)

49. SFX: DOG BARKING IN THE DISTANCE

50. **Mekete:** Oh! Challa, I don't know why your dog is

always following us especially when we're on a

critical mission. Hey, Challa, what are you

waiting for?

**51. Challa:** (Laughs) Oh, that dog again.

52. **Jonas:** (Laughs) You want a stone to throw at it?

Here's one.

53. Challa: Give it to me.

54. SFX: DOG BARKING FROM DISTANCE FADEOUT

55. Challa: He's a quick learner. (They all laugh).

56. **Jonas:** He ran away before you even took the stone

out of my hand.

57. **Mekete:** OK, pass me a light again.

KW end

58. SFX: FIRING MATCH

59. WIND IS BLOWING, THUNDERING

60. **Mekete:** Oh, this damn wind! I can't light the joint!

61. **Jonas:** Wait! I'll put my hands up as a windbreak.

(Pause)

62. SFX: FIRING MATCH

63. Mekete: Yes! (Inhales the marijuana deep and

exhales). Here! Challa, it's your turn.

64. Challa: Let's enjoy this first, and later at midnight we

can simply jump over the compound fence.

(Inhales the marijuana deep and exhales).

65. **Jonas:** So, have we got everything?

66. **Challa:** Lighten up with all your lists! Let me enjoy the

spliff first!

67. **Jonas:** I mean, did you remember to organize the

meat and the poison?

68. **Challa:** Hey! Don't worry about the poison. I buried it

next to the rich man's compound.

69. **Mekete:** Why did you do that? Why didn't you bring it

with you?

70. **Challa:** Hey! Don't forget, it's poisoned meat! What I've

done is the best solution. When we get there, we can dig up the poisoned meat and throw it to his damn dangerous dog! We shouldn't carry

stuff like that around with us. That's why!

71. **Jonas:** That's true!

72. **Mekete:** Oh yes! **(Smokes the joint).** We shouldn't

carry that kind of stuff around with us (all

laugh).

#### 73. SFX: WINDS BLOWING, AND THUNDERING

74. **NARRATION:** A little bit later that night, the drunkard Minabu comes home. He lives right next to Kassech and Papa Tilahun's house. Surprisingly, Minabu isn't drunk. He's been running fast because of the rain. He's puffed but doesn't say a word. While he searches for his keys, Papa Tilahun comes out and greets Minabu. He's very surprised to see the drunkard in such a sober state for this time of night.

## SCENE THREE: NIGHT OUTSIDE MR. MINABU'S COMPOUND

75. SFX: Night sounds, RAIN

**76. SFX: CLINKING KEYS** 

77. **Minabu:** Oh! Papa Tilahun, I didn't see you, good

evening!

78. **Papa Tilahu:** Good evening, Mr. Minabu! You're home very

early tonight.

79. **Minabu:** Yes, I am, Papa Tilahun.

80. Papa Tilahu: (Hesitantly) Is everything all right?

81. **Minabu:** Yes, why do you ask, Papa Tilahun?

82. Papa Tilahu: It's very strange not to hear your voice

booming through the darkness like we normally

do!

83. **Minabu:** Oh! Papa Tilahun, I've told myself, "It's

enough!" And I think if you honestly decide to

change, then nothing can stop you from

making that change.

84. **Papa Tilahu:** You're right, Mr. Minabu! Many people suffer

because they don't understand what you've

said right now.

85. **Minabu:** Yes, Papa Tilahun! But for me, it's an honest

decision!

**86. Papa Tilahu:** That's a result of my daily, early morning

prayers.

87. Minabu: (Laughs) Thank you very much, Papa Tilahun!

88. Papa Tilahu: No problem at all!

89. **Minabu:** I realized that I had became a bad example,

especially for the teenagers in this town, so I

decided to minimize my alcohol consumption.

90. Papa Tilahu: Minimize? Why don't you stop drinking

completely?

91. **Minabu:** I'll stop drinking sometime in the near future.

92. **Papa Tilahu:** Good to hear! The main point is that you plan

to stop.

93. Minabu: For sure!

KW begin

94. Papa Tilahu: (Speaks in low voice) Did you see your

neighbor, Kassech, today?

95. **Minabu:** No! Has her kid disappeared again?

96. Papa Tilahu: No, he hasn't.

97. **Minabu:** Her light's out.

98. **Papa Tilahu:** Yes, I told her to take a rest. She might be

asleep already.

99. **Minabu:** Oh! I understand.

100. Papa Tilahu: You should also switch your light off and take a

rest.

101. **Minabu:** I'll do that, Papa Tilahun, now I've found my

key.

102. SFX: CLINKING KEYS

#### KW end

103. Papa Tilahu: Good night, then!

**104. Minabu:** Good night!

105. SFX: DOOR BEING UNLOCKED AND OPEN

106. SFX: DOOR BEING CLOSED

107. SFX: DOOR BEING LOCKED

108. **NARRATION:** Minabu goes straight to bed. Except for the soft patter of falling rain, the night is very quiet. However, there is something stirring in the neighborhood. The three teenage boys are standing in front of Mr. Kasu's compound, utterly dumfounded by what's has just taken place right before their eyes.

# SCENE FOUR: NIGHT OUTSIDE MR. KASU'S COMPOUND

109. SFX: DOG BARKING INSIDE THE COMPOUND

110. SFX: ANOTHER DOG BARKING OUTSIDE THE COMPOUND

111. **Challa:** Stop that dog!

112. **Jonas:** What?

113. **Mekete:** (In a low voice) Keep quiet!

114. **Challa:** Oh no! The stupid dog has taken off with the

poisoned meat.

115. **Mekete:** You said you buried it!

116. Challa: I did but as you saw that stupid dog dug it up

and run off with it.

117. **Jonas:** What shall we do now? We don't have any

more poison to knock out the dog in the

compound!

118. SFX: DOG BARKING INSIDE THE COMPOUND

119. **Mekete:** (In a low voice) Forget the front gate! Let's try

the back.

120. SFX: THREE PEOPLE WALK ON A GRAVEL ROAD

121. SFX: DOG BARKING STOP

#### **OUTRO:**
