### **INTRO:**

Hello, dear listeners, and welcome to the last episode of our drama "The Lost Kid – the Story of Single Mothers in Africa." To recap, in our last episode, Jonas was shot by Mr. Kasu when he and his friends tried to break into the rich man's house. Fortunately, Jonas is still alive, but at the hospital. His two friends and Mr. Kasu are at the police station now. What Jonas didn't know is that the man who shot him is his father. At the same time, the young girl Aster decided to track Jonas down and tell him that she's in love with him. Today's last episode is called, "The Healing Process." We start at Kassech's place. She has heard the terrible news about her brother Jonas being shot and has also found out that Mr. Kasu is also her father. She is completely shocked by the night's events.

# **SCENE ONE: DAY AT KASSECH**

1. SFX: DAYTIME AMB, SOUP BOILING

2. **Kassech:** (Sobs) Yes, you're right. What if he had been

killed?

3. **Askale:** Thank God, he is in a stable condition. He's

lucky that the bullet just grazed his thigh.

**4. Kassech:** I can't believe Mr. Kasu is our father! And my

father shot my brother! UNBELIEVABLE!

5. Askale:

It's a pretty fantastic story! Especially considering last time we saw each other, you told me that you didn't have the slightest clue who your father was.

6. Kassech:

It turns out Papa Tilahun and Mama Beletu knew who he was all along!

7. Askale:

(Surprises) What!? Both of them knew who your father was? Why didn't they tell you?

8. Kassech:

(Unhappy) It's complicated, my dear! I'll explain the situation to you one day. Are you going to come with me to the hospital later?

9. Askale:

Sure! I've cooked something for Jonas. We can ask a friend to look after Begidu and Samy; and then I'll take care of both of them when I come back from the hospital. That way you can stay there as long as you need to.

10. Kassech:

Thanks, my dear!

11. Askale:

Don't worry! You saw Jonas this morning and you know he's going to be fine. The most important thing is that he understands, he made a big mistake. He needs to come home! You have to forgive him.

12. **Kassech:** I've been racking my brain thinking about how

that is going to work. The problem is Jonas has no mother who can give him advice (cries) and even though he now knows who his father is,

what kind of a father is that? He has never

looked after Jonas: he shot him instead! (Cries

more).

**KW BEGIN** 

13.Askale: Kassech, please don't cry! It was just a

coincidence that Jonas tried to break into his

father's house.

**14.Kassech:** Askale, why does life treats us like this?

15.**Askale:** My dear, life is difficult for everyone; be strong.

16.Kassech: I'll try, but right now everything seems like a

bad dream. Anyway, I have to focus on the

here and now.

17.**Askale:** I'm really glad to hear that, Kassech. Believe

me, I'm always here if you need me.

18.SFX: POT IS ABOUT TO BOIL OVER

19. **Askale:** Watch out, your pot's about to boil over!

20. SFX: COOKING POT'S LID BEING LIFTED

21. **Kassech:** Thanks, my dear! Call me when you're ready to

go.

22. **Askale:** I will! See you in a little bit!

23. SFX: SOMEONE LEAVES

#### **KW END**

24. NARRATION: Children orientate themselves on what they see happening around them. This means they need a positive role model. If they don't have a positive role model in early childhood, it is difficult to shape the child's behavior later on. This is what we've seen in Jonas' case. Children's early development period divides in three phases. The first early phase is from birth to six years, the next phase called middle childhood is from seven years to 11 years; and finally, there is an early adolescent age from 12 to 14 years. Children have their own special needs in each phase. Jonas has already grown out of all three phases. His sister Kassech tried her best to raise him, but she was too young and overwhelmed with raising her own son and earning enough to feed the family.

# SCENE TWO: DAY, OUTSIDE AT PAPA TILAHUN'S COMPOUND

25. SFX: DAYTIME AMBIENCE

26. **Papa Tilahun:** Mama Beletu! Come outside!

27. **Mama Beletu:** (From inside) Just a minute! I'm coming, Papa

Tilahun.

28. Papa Tilahun: (Angry) Do I have to wait for you forever?

29. Mama Beletu: I said, I'm coming!

KW begin

30. **Askale:** Good afternoon, Papa Tilahun! You're in a

hurry.

31. Papa Tilahun: (Gets angry) Well, I'm trying to be in a hurry

but my wife can't seem to leave the kitchen!
We've to go to the hospital right now! Oh!

Askale, excuse me! Good afternoon! (Askale

laughs).

32. Askale: Good afternoon! Kassech and I are getting

ready to go to the hospital, too.

33. Papa Tilahun: We've sent our granddaughter ahead, but we

want to be there early.

34. **Askale:** We'll see each other there then. (She leaves).

**35.Papa Tilahun:** Good day!

36. **Askale:** Till then!

KW end

37. Papa Tilahun: (To mama Beletu) Mama Beletu! Beletu!

Bele...

38. Mama Beletu: (Before he finishes the word, arrives) Yes!

I'm here.

39. Papa Tilahun: Oh! Woman, I can never seem to tear you

away from that kitchen of yours.

40. Mama Beletu: (Gets angry) I'd like to see how far you'd come

in the kitchen without me! At least, help me by

holding this pot - I've prepared something hot

for Jonas.

41. **Papa Tilahun:** OK, OK. Sorry! I'll carry it for you.

SCENE THREE: AFTERNOON IN THE HOSPITAL CORRIDOR

**42. SFX: HOSPITAL CORRIDOR** 

43. SFX: ARRANGING A BUNDLE OF ROSES

44. **NARRATION:** By the time Papa Tilahun and Mama Beletu arrive at the hospital, their granddaughter Aster is already there. She stands in the hospital corridor holding a bundle of roses in her hands. Suddenly, she sees her grandparents. Weighed down by all the things

they are carting, they look very tired.

45. **Aster:** Grandma, Grandpa, what are all these things

you are carrying?

46. Mama Beletu: I think you know, we're here to visit a patient.

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47. Papa Tilahun: We're not on vacation. Help us! What are you

staring at?

**48.Aster:** Wait here, Grandpa. Please. I want to go inside

first and surprise him with these flowers.

49. **Mama Beletu.** All right! Go and surprise Jonas. We'll wait for

you here but don't stay too long!

50. **Aster:** I won't. Grandpa, aren't these flowers

beautiful?

51. **Papa Tilahu:** Yes, they are very beautiful, just like you.

52. **Aster:** (Laughs joyfully) Wait for me here, OK, I'll call

you when I am finished. (She is leaving and

enters the room).

#### 53. SFX: DOOR OPENS AND CLOSES

### **KW BEGIN**

**54. Papa Tilahun:** (Surprised) Ah, the young generation!

55. Mama Beletu: (Chuckles) I already knew.

56. Papa Tilahun: (Suspicious) What did you already know?

57. Mama Beletu: I knew why that cell phone is always glued to

her ear.

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58. Papa Tilahun: It's obvious! Because she is talking to her best

friend, Semira.

59. Mama Beletu: No, no, no!

60. Papa Tilahun: Why then?

61. Mama Beletu: (In a low voice) Our granddaughter is in love.

62. **Papa Tilahun:** If that's true love, why not? True love is a good

foundation for building a strong family. Just like

us. (Both laughs). But, say, who's the lucky

boy?

63. **Mama Beletu:** The lucky boy is getting flowers as we speak.

64. Papa Tilahun: What? You mean our Jonas? (Whispering)

Let's go in.

### **KW END**

65. NARRATION: While Aster is handing the flowers to Jonas, her grandparents secretly sneak in to the room. However, the young lovers don't realize that the old couple are there.

## **SCENE FOUR: AFTERNOON IN THE HOSPITAL ROOM**

66. **Aster:** I don't know how to tell you, Jonas. I don't have

the words.

67. **Jonas:** You're my angel, Aster!

68. SFX: DOOR OPENS SLOWLY IN BACKGROUND

69. Aster: I love you so much, Jonas!

70. Jonas: (Lovingly) I love you so much too, Aster.

71. **Aster:** Do you like the flowers?

72. **Jonas:** Yes, I love them!

73. Papa Tilahun: We also love the flowers (Laughs from far).

74. **Jonas:** Oh! (Surprised)

75. **Mama Beletu:** They are very beautiful, indeed!

76. Aster: (A bit embarrassed) Grandma, grandpa, I...

77. **Mama Beletu:** Don't feel so ashamed, my child.

78. SFX: DOOR OPEN

79. SFX: TWO PEOPLE COME IN

**80. SFX: DOOR CLOSE** 

81. Papa Tilahun: Oh! Kassech.

82. **Mama Beletu:** Askale, you've both arrived at the right time.

83. **Kassech:** Hello! What's going on here?

84. **Askale:** Hello! Aster, you look tired!

**85.Aster:** (Embarrassed) Hello.

**86. Mama Beletu:** She didn't sleep.

87. **Papa Tilahun:** No, she's a little bit embarrassed.

88. **Aster:** (Still embarrassed) Grandpa!

89. SFX: DOOR OPEN

90. SFX: SOMEONE ENTERS

91. SFX: DOOR CLOSE

92. **Minabu:** Who's a little bit embarrassed? I hope, it's not

me. (He laughs, everyone laugh).

93. Papa Tilahun: Oh! Mr. Minabu. Welcome! Indeed, you have

nothing to be embarrassed about anymore.

You've already quit drinking. (Still laughing).

94. **Minabu:** Look at this scar on my forehead. It's a peace

pact between me and my old foe, alcohol! (All

laughs).

95. **Papa Tilahun:** Kassech, we talked to your father, Mr. Kasu

last night at the police station. He told us he

regrets so much what he has done.

96. **Mama Beletu:** They will release him very soon. His lawyer is

counting on self-defense.

97. **Minabu:** Now it's time to change our ways. We need to

heal our spirits for the sake of our children!

98. **Papa Tilahun:** I like that expression, "now it's time to change

our ways." I think that's why you were the first

to turn over a new leaf. (All laughs).

99. Minabu: I hope I didn't leave it to late - if I had changed

my ways earlier I wouldn't have this scar on my

forehead.

100. Papa Tilahun: Hopefully, there won't be any more scars on

your forehead.

101. **Minabu:** Not anymore, Papa Tilahun. NOT anymore!

(All laugh).

102. **Kassech:** Hey! Let's not forget about our patient.

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103. Askale: Don't worry, he is in good hands. Isn't he, Aster? (All laugh).
