INTRO

1. NARRATOR:

Nice to meet you all again for "Crossroads Generation - Facing the

Consequences". We're about to start the seventh episode of this second

season. Let's just recap what's happened so far... 15-year-old Trudy got a

surprising offer from her ex-boyfriend, the bus conductor Manoti:

2. EPISODE 2, LINES 60 – 64:

MANOTI: (...) I want us to move in together.

SFX: BOOKS FALLING DOWN

TRUDY: What?

MANOTI: I love you, Trudy.

TRUDY: Manoti... I... I don't know.

3. NARRATOR:

Trudy's classmates also have a lot on their minds. Niki can't seem to get over the fact that Mercy, the girl of his dreams, has rejected him. In the last episode, his parents found him lying in the street, completely drunk.

Meanwhile, Mercy's father, Msoto, is being held at the police station on suspicion of robbery. But did he really do it? We'll find out today...

Msoto's daughter Mercy has a completely different problem. She's pregnant by her classmate Dan, but he's avoiding his responsibilities. He told Mercy rather brutally that she should have an abortion. But he's not sure he managed to convince her. Dan's friend Biko has given him some advice:

4. EPISODE 5, LINE 109:

BIKO: (...) Sometimes all girls want is for us guys to ask nicely!

5. NARRATOR:

And that's also the name of today's episode: "Talk to Her Nicely". We start at Bongo Academy, the school Dan, Mercy and all the others go to...

SCENE 1: AT BONGO ACADEMY

6. SFX: BONGO ACADEMY CLASSROOM, INTERIOR ATMO

7. SFX: SCHOOL BELL RINGS

8. JULIETTE: Okay class, that's all for today. See you tomorrow!

Don't forget to hand in your papers before class! And

Niki: I'd like you to come to my office in fifteen minutes.

9. SFX: DOOR OPENING, HIGH-HEELED FOOTSTEPS LEAVING (JULIETTE)

10. SFX: NOISE AS CLASS PACKS AND DISPERSES

11. DAN: Hey, Mercy, wait up!

12. MERCY: What do you want, Dan? Just leave me alone, okay?

KW BEGIN

13. DAN: Come on! Mercy, we need to talk.

14. MERCY: (angry) Oh, *now* you want to talk, Dan? I thought you

told me not to come near you again!

15. DAN: (trying to keep it down) Not so loud! Please, can I

talk to you in private?

16. MERCY: Don't be silly. Almost everyone else has gone! And you should go, too.

17. DAN: (sudden change of tone, sweetly) I want us to be together again, Mercy. I miss you.

18. MERCY: (flatly) Stop it, Dan. I've had enough. I'm tired of your games, and I'm tired of you hurting me!

19. DAN: (trying to convince her) I know, Mercy, and that's why
I need you to hear me out!

20. MERCY: I can only stay five minutes. My mother's being very strict all of a sudden. I think she suspects something.

What is it you need to tell me?

KW END

21. DAN: Mercy, I love you...

22. MERCY: (loudly) Is this the way you love, Dan? Using me, then dumping me like garbage and insulting me?

23. DAN: Mercy, I was just confused.

24. MERCY: I don't think you were confused when you made me

pregnant. I don't think you were confused when you

said you were crazy about me, or when you threw

money at me in the street. You made it very, very clear

that I meant nothing to you!

25. DAN: I want to apologize.

26. MERCY: Apologize? It's too late for that! I'm pregnant, Dan -

(breaks down) I'm pregnant, but I'm having to deal

with it all alone. As if we didn't do this together!

27. DAN: Please don't cry.

28. MERCY: (sniffles)

29. DAN: I want us to be back together, just like it was before.

But you have to get rid of it, Mercy.

30. MERCY: Oh, so this is what it's all about again? Me terminating

the p-- (stops in horror as footsteps approach)

31. SFX: HIGH-HEELED FOOTSTEPS APPROACHING

32. JULIETTE: Terminating what, Mercy? What is going on here?

33. SILENCE

34. DAN: (scared) Madame ... errr ... Principal ... Juliette...

35. MERCY: (pulling herself together) The paper. Dan here offered to help me, but I think I need to do it alone.

36. DAN: (in relief) Yes, the paper! I thought a little teamwork might be appreciated!

37. JULIETTE: (stern) Dan, what you might call teamwork is what we teachers call cheating. No teamwork! (to Mercy)

Mercy, are you all right?

38. MERCY: (still sniffling) I'm fine, thank you, Madam Principal, I think I've just got a cold.

39. JULIETTE: (not convinced) Hmmm... Okay. See you both tomorrow. With two very different papers! Is that clear?
Now, get out of here.

40. DAN/MERCY: Yes, Principal Juliette.

41. JULIETTE: (to herself) Now, where did I leave my notes? (fade out as we follow Dan and Mercy)

42. SFX: FOOTSTEPS OF DAN AND MERCY IN THE HALLWAY

43. DAN: (they whisper) That was close! I'm glad she didn't

hear us talking about you-know-what.

44. MERCY: I am not going to talk about that in school any more.

45. DAN: Mercy, I care about you. And I don't want you to drop

out of school because of this.

46. SFX: FOOTSTEPS STOP

47. MERCY: (realizes) *You're* scared of Principal Juliette!

48. DAN: No, that's not true. I just want what's best for you.

49. MERCY: Dan --

50. DAN: If it's about the money --

51. MERCY: (cuts in decisively) Dan, just leave it. You only get to

treat me badly once, and you've more than used up

that chance. I'm out of here.

52. SFX: FOOTSTEPS AS MERCY LEAVES

53. DAN: Mercy, wait! Are you ... going to do it or not?

54. MERCY: (calls back) That's not your business any more, Dan!

55. DAN: (to himself) Damn! So much about talking nicely...

Thanks, Biko, for that great advice!

56. MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 2: MANOTI AT HIS MOTHER'S PLACE

57. ATMO: RURAL BACKGROUND

58. SFX: STEPS APPROACHING ON GRASS

59. MABEL: (sickly) Is that you, my son Manoti?

60. MANOTI: Yes, it's me. Hi, Mum. Are you feeling any better?

61. MABEL: I'd feel much better if I had grandchildren running

around this house. Then I'd be able to die in peace.

62. MANOTI: You're not going to die, mother. You've been talking

like this for many years now.

KW BEGIN

63. MABEL: You know nothing, my son. If I gave you these tired old

bones of mine for a day, then maybe you'd understand.

Please, give me some of that tea over there.

64. SFX: TEA BEING POURED INTO CUP, MABEL DRINKING

65. MABEL: So, tell me, Manoti. When are you going to marry so

that I can see my grandchildren?

66. MANOTI: You're blind, Mother. You can't see.

67. MABEL: Huh. You've always had a sharp tongue. My blindness

should be a reminder to you that youth fades.

68. MANOTI: Have you eaten anything?

KW END

69. MABEL: Are you listening to what I'm saying, Manoti? Hurry up

and get me a grandson!

70. MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 3: AT THE PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE

71. ATMO: INTERIOR ATMO, BONGO ACADEMY, DAYTIME, AFTER

SCHOOL.

72. JULIETTE: Niki, how are you?

73. NIKI: Okay, thanks, Principal Juliette.

74. JULIETTE: How are your parents?

75. NIKI: They're okay too. Why?

76. SFX: PAPERS BEING SHUFFLED

77. **JULIETTE:** I've noticed that your grades have dropped a lot lately.

And you don't seem to be concentrating in class any

more. I've even caught you several times without your

homework. Niki, we have high hopes of you. You've

always been one of our best students. What's going

on?

78. NIKI: (trying to sound convincing) Nothing, I... I... We just

have a lot of work in all our subjects at the moment.

79. JULIETTE: I know that. But please - keep working hard, okay?

80. NIKI: Yes, Madam Juliette.

81. JULIETTE: Please remember: as class prefect, you should serve

as a role model to your classmates. If you don't, I'll

have to make somebody else prefect.

82. NIKI: Yes, Madam Juliette. I promise I won't disappoint you

again.

83. JULIETTE: You can go now.

84. SFX: FOOTSTEPS NIKI LEAVES

KW BEGIN

85. JULIETTE: Oh - Niki, one last thing. As a prefect, you are our eyes

and ears in the classroom. What's going on between

Mercy and Dan?

86. NIKI: (from the door) Er... I don't know, Principal Juliette.

87. JULIETTE: All right. Goodbye, Niki.

88. NIKI: Goodbye.

KW END

89. SFX: DOOR OPENS AND CLOSES

90. MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 4: MUKARABA BRIBING THE POLICE

91. ATMO: EVENING SOUNDS IN A QIUET ENVIRONMENT, CRICKETS

92. SFX: OFFICER'S FOOTSTEPS ON GRAVEL

KW BEGIN

93. SFX: CELLPHONE RINGS, CALL ANSWERED

94. OFFICER MNENE: Hello? Officer Mnene speaking.

95. MUKARABA: (on phone) Hello Officer, this is Mukaraba.

96. MNENE: Where are you?

97. MUKARABA: I parked in the usual place.

98. MNENE: Okay. I'm coming.

99. SFX: PHONE CALL DISCONNECTED

KW END

100. SFX: FOOTSTEPS STOP

101. SFX: CAR WINDOW ROLLING DOWN AUTOMATICALLY

102. MUKARABA: (low voice) Hello, Officer Mnene. Are you sure nobody followed you?

103. MNENE: (offended) Councillor Mukaraba, I am a policeman. I would know if somebody was following me.

104. SFX: BILLS BEING COUNTED AND HANDED OVER

105. MUKARABA: Here's the money, Officer. Now you make absolutely sure that Msoto rots in the cells forever and nobody ever finds out I framed him for the robbery.

- 106. MNENE: (low voice) This is not enough! It's getting difficult to hold him for the robbery without any evidence. And now things are even more complicated. His wife Lulu has been visiting the police station every day. She keeps asking for her baby. The one you bought off her husband...
- 107. MUKARABA: Listen to me, Officer. Money is not a problem. There's plenty more where that came from. You just make sure you keep your part of the deal.
- 108. MNENE: If that's the case, Councillor, then I assure you Msoto won't be getting out for a very long time! All you have to do is make sure we don't go hungry, if you know what I mean. (laughs)
- **109. MUKARABA:** What about his wife? What if she starts screaming for her baby again?

110. MNENE: Leave that to me. All she needs to know is that we are still "processing" the case, and in this country that could take years (laughs sarcastically). I told her the baby was with social services.

111. MUKARABA: (laughs) If that's what my home is called nowadays...

But make sure the press doesn't get wind of this. I'm a politician, remember. We don't want my name on the front pages for the wrong reason!

112. SFX: ELECTRIC CAR WINDOW CLOSING

113. SFX: CAR DRIVES OFF

114. SFX: STEPS AS OFFICER LEAVES

115. MNENE: (whistling/humming happily)

116. OUTRO – NARRATOR:

And that's it for today. Will Mukaraba and the corrupt police officer succeed in keeping this quiet? And what's in store for Mercy, Dan, Niki and Trudy?
