INTRO

1. NARRATOR:

Hi there – welcome to episode number eight of our radio drama "Crossroads Generation – Facing the Consequences". A lot has been happening lately in the lives of the teenagers Mercy, Trudy, Niki and Dan. Trudy has received a surprising proposal from her ex-boyfriend Manoti, who's much older than she is: he's asked her to move in with him. But last time we learned that Manoti has a particular reason for doing this – his mother:

2. EPISODE 7, LINES 65 – 69 (alternative: starting from line 61):

MABEL: So, tell me, Manoti. When are you going to marry so that I can see my grandchildren? (...)

MANOTI: Have you eaten anything, mother?

MABEL: Are you listening to what I'm saying, Manoti? Hurry up and get me a grandson!

3. NARRATOR:

Trudy's best friend Mercy is pregnant, and Dan, the father, is trying everything he can to convince her to have an abortion:

4. EPISODE 7, LINES 29 - 30:

DAN: I want us to be back together, just like it was before. But you have to get rid of it, Mercy.

MERCY: Oh, so this is what it's all about again? (...)

5. NARRATOR:

Today's episode is called "Women's Talk". Sit back and come with us to Tandika slums, where Mercy, her mother and her two brothers are about to start their day.

SCENE 1: MERCY PUKES

6. ATMO: MORNING IN TANDIKA SLUMS, INTERIOR ATMO

KW BEGIN

7. BANDA: (coughs)

8. LULU: Banda, that cough still isn't getting better. Have you

been drinking your lemon water?

9. BANDA: (coughs) Yes, Mama.

10. SFX: MERCY BEING SHAKEN

11. LULU: Mercy, wake up! Are you going to spend the whole

day asleep on that mattress? No wonder it's worn

out!

12. MERCY: (grumbles sleepily and mumbles under blanket)

13. LULU: What did you say? I didn't hear you.

KW END

14. MERCY: (lazily and moodily) Mum, why do I have to get up

so early? It's Saturday.

15. LULU: Because I said so. Get up and go and buy me some

charcoal, will you. I need to iron this dress before I

go to the police station.

16. MERCY: (rudely) Why don't you buy charcoal yourself? I'm

tired!

17. LULU: (stern) I'm sorry, what did you say?

18. MERCY: Nothing.

19. BANDA: Mum, are you going to see Dad at the police

station? Is he still under arrest?

20. LULU: Yes, Banda. Your father's still there. But I'm not

going to see him. I have other things to do there.

(to Mercy) And as for you, Miss Grumpy...

21. SFX: BLANKET PULLED AWAY

22. LULU: Come out from under this blanket right now! What's

the matter with you?

23. SFX: MERCY STANDING UP

24. MERCY: (to herself) Oh no....

25. SFX: RUNNING FOOTSTEPS (BAREFOOT) LEAVE

26. LULU: Hey... hey! Mercy, where are you going with only a

nightdress on? Come back here! Mercy! Mercy!

(to herself) What's wrong with that girl?

27. MERCY: (PUKES OUTSIDE)

28. SFX: SOUND OF SOMEBODY PUKING OUTSIDE

29. LULU: (Shouts) Mercy! Are you sick? Mercy!

30. MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 2: AT TRUDY'S

31. ATMO: RADIO MUSIC IN THE BACKGROUND

32. SFX: TRUDY'S CELLPHONE RINGS

33. SFX: BED CREAKS

34. TRUDY: (yawns; to herself) Oh, it's my mother.

35. SFX: BEEP AS CALL IS ANSWERED

36. TRUDY: Hello, Mama.

37. MAMA TRUDY: (on phone) Hello Trudy, my daughter. How are

you? You tried to call me yesterday?

38. TRUDY: Yes, Mama. Why didn't you pick up? Where are

you?

KW BEGIN

39. MAMA TRUDY: (ignores the question) What was it you wanted to

talk to me about?

40. TRUDY: Mama, when are you coming home?

41. MAMA TRUDY: Soon, Trudy. Very soon.

42. TRUDY: But you've been gone for over a week now! I want

you here! And since you fired the housemaid I'm all

alone in the house ... And I don't know what to

eat...

43. MAMA TRUDY: (cuts in) Is the food I left already finished?

44. TRUDY: Almost. You didn't leave much.

45. MAMA TRUDY: Just be patient, Trudy. I'll send you some money, all

right?

46. TRUDY: (desperate) But Mama, why are you never home?

Where are you?

KW END

47. MAMA TRUDY: You're a big girl now, Trudy. Listen --

48. TRUDY: You're always telling me to listen. I don't want to

listen any more. Just come home - otherwise l'Il

move in with Manoti. He's already asked me.

49. MAMA TRUDY: (shocked) What? Trudy! Who is this Manoti?

50. TRUDY: He's --

51. MAMA TRUDY: (cuts her short, firm) Now you listen to me, young

lady! You will do no such a thing! You're far too

young to get married!

52. TRUDY: I'm not getting married. I'm just moving in with him.

53. MAMA TRUDY: That's more or less the same thing.

54. TRUDY: Look who's talking. You're the one who changes

men like clothes. At least I've picked one!

55. MAMA TRUDY: Don't talk to me like that! I'm your mother!

56. TRUDY: Come home, then!

57. MAMA TRUDY: | will.

58. TRUDY: When? I want you now!

59. MAMA TRUDY: Soon. Trudy, listen to me. If your father finds out

that you're not living with me any more and you're

not going to school, he'll stop paying our rent.

60. TRUDY: (crying) Yeah, right! All you are care about is your

stupid rent. You don't even know what I eat. You

know what? Don't bother coming back. By the time

you do, I'll probably already be married to Manoti.

61. MAMA TRUDY: (pleading) Trudy! Wait! (deep breath) Okay. You can move in with this Manoti, if that's really what you want. But promise me you'll keep going to

school, okay? Otherwise --

62. TRUDY: (cuts in, angry) Yeah, I know. The rent. Just... just leave me alone. I'm not your daughter any more.

63. SFX: PHONE DISCONNECTS

64. TRUDY: (cries)

65. MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 3: DAN AND BIKO PLAY BASKETBALL

66. BONGO ACADEMY: OUTSIDE, WEEKEND, DAYTIME

67. SFX: BASKETBALL BEING DRIBBLED

68. BIKO: (Heavy panting) Who's the man now? Who's the

man? Dan, you can't get past me! They don't call

me "Barrel Biko" for nothing!

69. DAN: (Pants as he dribbles) Barrel Biko had better

watch out – here comes "Dribbling Dan"!

70. SFX: SCUFFLE AND DRIBBLING AS THEY PLAY BASKETBALL.

71. DAN: He turns, he runs, he jumps, and – he scores!

72. SFX: BASKETBALL BEING THROWN INTO BASKET

73. DAN: (Laughs) "Barrel Biko" can't stop me!

74. BIKO: (Still panting) Oh, come on, Dan!

75. DAN: (Laughs) Want some more?

76. BIKO: No, I need a break. Let's sit down

77. DAN: Okay.

78. SFX: RUSTLING OF CLOTHES AS THEY SIT

79. BIKO: (Catches his breath) Hey, Dan – how did it go with

Mercy? Did you talk to her nicely?

80. DAN: Yeah, like you told me to.

81. BIKO: And?

82. DAN: I don't think it worked. And Principal Juliette almost

overheard us!

83. BIKO: (dismissive) Cheer up, man! Mercy's probably

getting it done right now. Barrel Biko might not be all

that great at basketball, but he sure gives good

advice!

84. DAN: (sarcastic) Yeah, right. When I become president,

remind me to hire you as my advisor.

KW BEGIN

85. BIKO: (laughs) Other way round, mate.

86. DAN: Seriously, thanks for the support, Biko!

87. BIKO: No problem. You know I'd jump in front of a train for

you --

88. DAN: (cuts in) Yeah, I know --

89. BIKO: -- as long as it's not moving! (Laughs)

90. DAN: You idiot! (they laugh)

91. MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 4: AT THE MSOTO FAMILY HOME IN TANDIKA

92. SFX: INTERIOR ATMO, TANDIKA SLUMS, MORNING

93. BANDA/KADU: EATING

94. SFX: SPOONING PORRIDGE

95. BANDA: Mum, is Mercy sick?

96. LULU: I don't know, Banda.

97. BANDA: She vomited. People only vomit when they're sick,

don't they? (coughs)

98. LULU: Finish your porridge, boys. And Banda, make sure

you drink your lemon water.

99. BANDA: (drinks)

100. KADU: (eats)

101. SFX: DOOR OPENS, FOOTSTEPS (BAREFOOT) APPROACH

102. LULU: Talk of the devil. Here she is. Mercy, sit down.

103. SFX: RUSTLING OF CLOTHES

104. LULU: Boys, go out and play. Mercy and I need to talk.

105. KADU: (mouth full) But Mum, we haven't finished --

106. LULU: (stern) You can finish later. Off you go.

107. KADU/BANDA: Okay...

108. SFX: FOOTSTEPS (2 KIDS), DOOR OPENS, SHUTS.

109. LULU: Okay, Mercy, now we're alone.

(deep breath, struggles to get the words out) | ...

Did you... (deep breath) Mercy, are you pregnant?

110. MERCY: (caught) Mum!

111. LULU: Just tell me, child. This is the third time I've seen

you vomiting in the morning. I know the signs.

KW BEGIN

112. MERCY: It's nothing, Mum. I just feel a little sick, that's all!

113. LULU: Mercy, I'm not a fool. If you don't tell me, who will

you tell? I promise you I won't be angry.

114. MERCY: (cries) I... Mum... I'm so sorry!

115. LULU: (angry) My God! What the hell is wrong with you? Is

this what they teach you in schools nowadays?

Can't you use your brain?

KW END

116. MERCY: (cries more) I'm sorry, Mum... I didn't mean this to

happen.

117. LULU: Who's responsible?

118. MERCY: (cries)

119. LULU: Answer me! Who?

120. MERCY: His name is Dan. He's from Laboria...

121. LULU: A ... a foreigner! Of all people, you choose a

foreigner to get pregnant with! Get out! Get out of

my sight, right now!

122. MERCY: (cries)

123. SFX: RUNNING FOOTSTEPS (MERCY)

124. SFX: DOOR OPENS AND CLOSES

125. LULU: Arrgh! I can't believe this. This is too much!

126. OUTRO - NARRATOR:

So Mercy's mother Lulu didn't keep her promise not to be angry. What will Mercy do now? And what about Mercy's father, who's still under arrest at the police station?
