<u>INTRO</u>

1. NARRATOR:

Hi there, and welcome to the fifth episode of our radio drama "Crossroads

Generation". This is our third season, called "Facing the Future", and a lot

has been happening lately! Mercy, Tina and Trudy are studying journalism

at university, but Mercy has other things on her mind right now. She has a

three-year-old daughter called Linda. Mercy's mother used to take care of

her, but she and Mercy have had a huge fight. The next day Mercy

confessed something to her best friend, Trudy:

FLASHBACK: EPISODE 4, LINES 103-107

MERCY: Linda's living here with me.

TRUDY: What?

MERCY: Shh!

TRUDY: Mercy, you know that's against the rules. What if the warden

finds out?

MERCY: I don't know, Trudy.

3. **NARRATOR:**

Mercy's boyfriend Niki wasn't very supportive, either:

4. FLASHBACK: EPISODE 4, LINES 45-47

NIKI: So now you just make decisions without telling me?

MERCY: Come on! We don't live together! I thought you'd understand...

Linda's my daughter!

NIKI: And I'm your boyfriend! You have to tell me these things!

5. NARRATOR:

Today's episode is called "No Picnic". But before we hear how Niki, Trudy and Mercy are doing, let's check on Mercy's younger brother Kadu. It's break time at his school...

SCENE 1: SAMA AND KADU TALK

6. ATMO: SCHOOLYARD, CHILDREN PLAYING IN THE BACKGROUND

7. SAMA: (from a distance, crying)

8. SFX: KADU'S FOOTSTEPS WALKING

9. KADU: Hey! Sama, why are you crying?

10. SAMA: (pretends) I'm not crying, Kadu!

11. KADU: Yes, you are.

12. SAMA: I'm not.

13. KADU: Come on, tell me. Is it those girls you were playing

with over there? You know I'm the class prefect! I

can report them to the teacher!

14. SAMA: (alarmed) No, no! Don't do that!

15. KADU: So what's going on? Tell me.

16. SAMA: Okay, but you have to promise you won't report

them.

17. KADU: All right.

18. SAMA: They say I can't play with them any more. And they

laughed at my yellow dress!

19. KADU: Why?

20. SAMA: They say I wear the same dress every day, and that

it stinks! But it's not true! I have lots of yellow

dresses, not just this one!

FLASHBACK: Ep. 6, line 2

21. KADU: So yellow's your favourite colour, is it, Sama?

22. SAMA: (shyly) It kind of is... In my family we all dress like

this. It's because of our religion. And my parents

say that --

23. KADU: Do they tell you you have to dress like that?

Because you could change here at school, you

know. They'd never know!

24. SAMA/KADU: (laugh)

25. SAMA: No, it's not like that. My parents said if the other kids

laugh at us we don't have to wear it.

26. KADU: Then why do you still wear a yellow dress?

27. SAMA: Because I like it! And I'm proud of my religion... But

the other girls don't understand.

28. KADU: Well, I like your dress!

29. SAMA: (shyly) Thank you, Kadu.

KW BEGIN

30. KADU: And I say we should report those girls right now!

31. SAMA: But Kadu, you promised!

32. KADU: Our teacher said no one should laugh at anyone

else because of their religion!

33. SAMA: Please, Kadu. If we report them, they'll never let me

play with them again!

34. KADU: (sighs) Okay.

KW END You know, my dad is very religious too. He just

came back to the city, and all he can talk about is

this King Karubu. He wants my brother and me to

go and pray with him...

35. SAMA: Do you go?

36. KADU: I don't like it! I don't understand what we're saying in

those prayers...

37. SAMA: My mum always says that belief comes from the

heart; you have to feel it. And I feel really good

when I pray with her.

38. KADU: (thinks) Hmmm... I don't feel anything when Dad

talks about King Karubu. But my brother Banda

seems to love it!

39. SAMA: (laughs shyly)

40. KADU: Hey, do you want to play with me and my friends

tomorrow?

41. SAMA: Maybe.

MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 2: MERCY'S DOUBTS ABOUT NIKI

42. ATMO: UNIVERSITY HOSTEL YARD, DAYTIME, OUTSIDE

43. SFX: CLOTHES BEING WASHED BY HAND

44. MERCY: (to herself) I didn't know I had so much dirty

laundry!

45. SFX: FOOTSTEPS APPROACH

46. TRUDY: Hey Mercy! Are you doing the washing for your

whole building?

47. MERCY: Oh, hi Trudy! I don't even know how I let them pile

up like this. And my daughter. She can be so

messy! She's playing over there peacefully now, but

once she gets bored or hungry or tired...

48. TRUDY: Come on, I'll help you.

49. MERCY: Oh! Thanks!

50. SFX: TWO PEOPLE WASHING CLOTHES BY HAND

KW BEGIN

51. TRUDY: Look, Mercy, maybe you could ask your mother to

take Linda again?

52. MERCY: Trudy --

53. TRUDY: I'm just saying... I mean, she helped you take care

of her all this time, while you finished school ...

54. MERCY: I just can't, okay? Not after what my father told me,

and after the fight I had with my mother... I don't

know who to trust any more!

KW END

55. TRUDY: What about Niki? Maybe he could help out with

Linda? He gets along well with her, doesn't he?

56. MERCY: That's what I thought too... But... (pause)

57. TRUDY: Hey, what is it?

58. MERCY: Nothing...

59. TRUDY: Come on, tell me!

FLASHBACK: Ep. 6, line 4

60. MERCY: It's just that Niki hasn't been taking my calls since I

told him Linda's come to live with me. Everything

was fine before, but now... I think it reminds him too

much of the fact that I had someone else's child.

61. TRUDY: I thought he accepted that long ago, back when you

two got together?

62. MERCY: I thought so too.

63. TRUDY: By the way, did you ever hear from Dan again?

64. MERCY: No, nothing! And I don't want to, either, after he

went back to Laboria as soon as Linda was born!

65. TRUDY: Tell you what... Let's forget about men! They're all

idiots, anyway! I've got some news for you.

66. MERCY: What news?

67. TRUDY: I got a job at a newspaper!

68. MERCY: Really? That's cool! What are you doing for them?

69. TRUDY: I... Well, they told me to...

70. MERCY: (interrupts her, shouts) Hey, Linda, don't go too

far! ...Linda! (to Trudy) Sorry, I'll be right back...

71. SFX: FOOTSTEPS – MERCY RUNNING AWAY

MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 3: NIKI ARGUES WITH HIS MOTHER

72. ATMO: INSIDE UNIVERSITY HOSTEL

73. SFX: KEYS JINGLE, DOOR OPENS

74. NIKI: (hums as he enters)

75. NIKI: (sniffs) Mff! These gym clothes smell terrible! I

have to take a quick shower before I go to afternoon

class!

76. SFX: NIKI'S MOBILE PHONE RINGS

77. SFX: BEEP AS CALL IS ANSWERED

78. NIKI: Hello?

79. MRS. JUMBE: (on phone) Hey Niki, my son. How are you?

80. NIKI: I'm fine, Mum.

81. MRS. JUMBE: Since you went to university it seems you've

forgotten all about us. You don't write, you don't call

. . .

82. NIKI: (laughs) You talk as if I'm living abroad. It's not that

far. And I came over to have lunch with Dad just the

other day...

83. MRS. JUMBE: (ignores him) Or is it that girlfriend of yours –

Mercy – who's keeping you away from us?

84. NIKI: Mum, stop it!

85. MRS. JUMBE: Seriously, Niki. When are you going to get over your

obsession with her?

86. NIKI: (angry) Mum. Is that why you called?

FLASHBACK: Ep. 12, line 2

87. MRS. JUMBE: I'm your mother. I'm worried about you, Niki. And I

don't think she's good for you! She has a child with

another man, and --

88. NIKI: (interrupts her) I know that! And I'm trying to come

to terms with it. But you reminding me about it all

the time doesn't make it any easier!

KW BEGIN

89. MRS. JUMBE: So why do you insist on being her boyfriend?

90. NIKI: (snaps) Because I love her, Mum, okay?! I love her,

and I don't know what else to do!

91. MRS. JUMBE: Niki, you're a handsome boy who can get any girl in

the world. You don't need --

92. NIKI: Stop it, Mum!

KW END

93. MRS. JUMBE: That girl is from the slums...

94. NIKI: I can't listen to this nonsense any more.

95. SFX: LINE DISCONNECTS

KW BEGIN

96. NIKI: (to himself) I've had enough of her controlling me

and telling me what's best for me!

97. SFX: PHONE RINGS

98. SFX: BEEP AS CALL IS ANSWERED

99. NIKI: Hello?

100. MRS. JUMBE: (on phone, not amused) Niki, how dare you hang

up on me --

101. SFX: PHONE DISCONNECTED AGAIN

102. NIKI: (to himself) Ha! And I'll do it again!

KW END

MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 4: TINA AND TRUDY OFFER TO 'STUDY' WITH MERCY

103. ATMO: LIBRARY ATMO

104. SFX: PAGES OF BOOK BEING TURNED

105. SFX: STEPS - MERCY ARRIVING

106. MERCY: (low voices throughout the scene) Hi Trudy, hi

Tina!

107. TRUDY/TINA: Hi, Mercy!

108. TRUDY: We've been waiting for you! We were supposed to

meet half an hour ago here in the library! We've

almost finished ...

109. MERCY: Sorry, Trudy! I had to take Linda to my next-door

neighbour in the hostel. She doesn't have classes

today, and she offered to take care of her.

110. SFX: CHAIR SCRAPING

111. SFX: CLOTHES RUSTLING AS MERCY SITS DOWN

112. TRUDY: You look stressed. Is everything okay?

113. MERCY: No! We're about to sit our first exams next week,

and I don't have the slightest idea what to write.

114. TINA: But that's because you've been missing classes!

115. MERCY: (sighs) Tina, you have no idea how hard it's been

with Linda around.

116. TINA: I think I do. Taking care of my brother and sisters at

home is no picnic, either... My brother's been

helping out a little more, though, since he got into

trouble and I was there for him.

117. MERCY: What happened?

118. TINA: (sighs) He had to be treated in hospital, and --

(changes her mind) Oh, let's not talk about it now.

Anyway, he's taking care of our sisters tonight, so

I'm free!

119. TRUDY: Cool! (pause) I have an idea. Tina, why don't we all

meet this evening to help Mercy cheer up?

(corrects herself) Er - I mean... catch up?!

(laughs)

120. TINA: Sounds like a good idea! What do you say, Mercy?

121. MERCY: Really? You'd do that for me?

122. TRUDY: Of course, silly! What are friends for?

123. MERCY: (happy) Oh, you two are amazing! You can come

over to my place, and --

124. TRUDY: No, no – we can't work in your room, with the little

one distracting us all the time.

125. MERCY: But I can't leave Linda on her own!

KW END

126. TRUDY: Tell you what, Mercy: ask your housemate to

babysit for you tonight, and we'll take you to a quiet

place to study. (laughs)

127. MERCY: Great. I'll ask her right away. I can't concentrate,

anyway.

128. SFX: CHAIR SCRAPING AND CLOTHES RUSTLING

129. SFX: MERCY'S STEPS LEAVING

130. TINA: (whispering to Trudy) Trudy – "a quiet place to

study"? Where can we go?

131. TRUDY: I want us to take her out, Tina. She's so stressed.

We could do with some fun, too, don't you think?

132. TINA: Good idea! I know a place where we can go...

133. TRUDY/ TINA: LAUGHTER

134. MERCY: (from afar) Hey, what are you two laughing about?

135. TRUDY/TINA: (at the same time) Nothing!

OUTRO - NARRATOR:
