## <u>INTRO</u>

## 1. NARRATOR:

Hi there! Today, we have a new episode of our radio series "Crossroads Generation" for you! Just to remind you where we left off last time: Mercy's father Msoto is back in town after his wife threw him out years ago. He claims to be a changed man, and to have been enlightened by the spirit of a certain King Karubu. But we saw a different side to his faith last time:

# 2. FLASHBACK: EPISODE 10, LINES 52-55, 72-73

MSOTO: (shouts to audience) My name is Msoto, and this is Ben, my brother in faith. We greet you all in the name of King Karubu!
BEN: (shouts) King Karubu! King Karubu! (...)
PASSENGER 1: Oh no! Not these bus preachers again. (...)
PASSENGER 2: What's wrong?
PASSENGER 1: The guy shouting "King Karubu" all the time! I think he's stealing from the passengers while the other one is preaching!

# 3. NARRATOR:

And this is not the first dirty deed Msoto has been involved in. Four years ago, he sold his own newborn baby girl to the local politician Mukaraba. Msoto's daughter Mercy talked about it to her friend Trudy.

They're both studying journalism, and Trudy used the information in an interview with Mukaraba. As a result, he threatened both girls. So last time, Trudy tried to stop her article from being published:

# 4. FLASHBACK: EPISODE 10, LINES 105-106

**TRUDY: (bursts in)** Please – don't print my story!

EDITOR: Too late, Trudy. It'll be on the front page tomorrow... (...)

# 5. NARRATOR:

Let's start right away to find out how the story goes on! This eleventh episode is called "Out in the Open".

# **SCENE 1: MERCY AT POLICE STATION**

## 6. ATMO: POLICE STATION ATMO

### **KW BEGIN**

- MERCY: Excuse me, Officer, my name is Mercy Msoto. I'm here to speak to Inspector Mary.
- 8. **OFFICER:** Do you have an appointment?
- 9. MERCY: Yes, my mother called her.
- **10. OFFICER:** Okay. Wait here. I'll tell her you're here.
- **11. MERCY:** Thank you.
- 12. SFX: TWO PAIRS OF FOOTSTEPS WALK AWAY

### **KW END**

- **13. MERCY:**(to herself) I really hope Inspector Mary can help!Mum says she's the right person to talk to...
- 14. SFX: FAST FOOTSTEPS APPROACHING
- **15. TRUDY:** (panting) Mercy! I was hoping I'd find you here!
- 16. MERCY: (not very friendly) Trudy? I thought you didn't want to go to the police!

**17. TRUDY:** Well, I've changed my mind!

# 18. SFX: FOOTSTEPS: INSP. MARY APPROACHING

- 19. INSP. MARY: Mercy Msoto?
- **20. MERCY:** That's me. And this is Trudy Kasingo.
- **21. INSP. MARY:** I'm Inspector Mary. Please, come with me to my office.
- 22. SFX: FOOTSTEPS (THREE PAIRS)
- 23. SFX: DOOR OPENING AND CLOSING
- 24. INSP. MARY: Have a seat.
- 25. MERCY/TRUDY: Thank you.
- 26. INSP. MARY: Now, Mercy: your mother mentioned that somebody threatened you on the phone in relation to the Mukaraba case?
- 27. MERCY: Yes.
- 28. INSP. MARY: Do you know why?
- **29. MERCY:** I just found out...

- 30. TRUDY: (clears her throat) It's because of me. I work for the Kisimba Tribune part-time, and I was working on a story about Mukaraba and the illegal adoption. I mentioned Mercy as my source during the interview with him...
- **31. INSP. MARY:** I see. First of all: don't they teach you at university to protect your sources?
- **32. TRUDY:** I... uh...
- **33. INSP. MARY:** And Mercy, your family had strict instructions not to talk about the case!
- **34. MERCY:** I... I know... I...
- **35. INSP. MARY:** But none of that is going to help us now that the cat is out of the bag. (deep breath) Trudy, how did Mukaraba react?
- **36. TRUDY:** He threatened to kill me.
- 37. INSP. MARY: What?
- **38. TRUDY:** I even recorded him saying it. This is the tape...
- 39. SFX: SMALL METAL BOX PUT ON DESK

- **40. INSP. MARY:** Okay. I'll keep this here as evidence.
- **41. TRUDY:** They didn't find it when they went through my stuff.
- 42. INSP. MARY: You've had death threats, and people breaking into your rooms? This is really serious! (deep breath)
  You did well to come to me, both of you. What about this article? Is it going to be published?
- 43. TRUDY: I tried to stop it, but the editor wouldn't listen to me!(low voice) It'll be on the front page tomorrow.
- **44. MERCY:** Trudy!
- 45. INSP. MARY: (deep breath) My my! Okay, let me think...
- 46. SFX: PAPERS RUSTLING

- 47. INSP. MARY: (to herself) There's very little time, but it should be possible... (to the girls) As you probably already know, Mercy, we've been preparing a case against Mukaraba to charge him with illegal adoption. It hasn't been made public yet; it was due to be announced in a few days. Given the circumstances, I'd like to make the announcement tonight, to make sure the information is out in the open as soon as possible.
- 48. TRUDY/MERCY: Thank you, Inspector!
- **49. INSP. MARY:** But I strongly advise you to be very, very careful, okay? Avoid being alone, only walk in groups, and don't stay out too late. If you notice anything unusual, call me. Okay? Even if it's late at night.
- 50. TRUDY/MERCY:Yes, Ma'am.

## SCENE 2: LULU GETS A CALL FROM INSPECTOR MARY

#### 51. ATMO: MARKET ATMO

#### **KW BEGIN**

- **52. LADY:** Hello, Mama Mercy! Can you help me out? I need change for a fifty. My customer's waiting...
- **53.** LULU: (grumpy) Sorry, I don't have any change.
- 54. LADY: Oh, is that your granddaughter Linda in the back of your shop? She hasn't been around here lately, has she! (calls) Linda!!! Hello there! (to Lulu) Oooh, she's so sweet!

### 55. SFX: LINDA LAUGHING FROM AFAR

- 56. LULU: (grumpy) I thought you just wanted change? I told you, I don't have any!
- **57.** LADY: Okay, okay! I get it!
- **58.** LULU: (sighs) Sorry. I didn't mean to snap at you. I just have a lot on my mind right now.
- **59.** LADY: It's all right. I understand. I need to go back,

anyway. (as she leaves) Bye, Mama Mercy!

60. LULU: Bye.

#### **KW END**

- 61. SFX: LULU'S MOBILE PHONE RINGS
- 62. SFX: BEEP AS CALL IS ANSWERED
- 63. LULU: Hello?
- **64. INSP. MARY:** Hello Lulu, this is Inspector Mary. I just spoke to your daughter, Mercy.
- **65. LULU:** Will everything be okay?
- 66. INSP. MARY: It should be. It was very good that she came to me, though. I hope she and her friend have learnt their lesson.
- **67. LULU:** They'd better!

### FLASHBACK: Ep. 12, line 4

- 68. INSP. MARY: Lulu, I'm also calling to tell you that the case against Mukaraba will be going to court next week.
- 69. LULU: Oh thank God. Finally!

- 70. INSP. MARY: There might be a lot of noise around it, but the important thing is that you and your husband stay calm. Mukaraba will know about the case now, and our investigation. But he still doesn't know that your husband is going to testify. He mustn't find out about that until it's time. You understand?
- 71. LULU: Of course! And I'll make sure Msoto does, too!
- 72. INSP. MARY: You might also want to tell him to stop ranting about someone called King Karubu in public places and on buses if he wants to be taken seriously as a witness! I've even heard people talking about some followers of King Karubu who stole from other passengers on a bus...
- **73. LULU:** What?! You can be quite sure I'll talk to him about this!
- **74. INSP. MARY:** Okay, then. I'll let you know when you need to appear in court.
- **75.** LULU: Okay. Thank you, Inspector Mary. Goodbye!

### 76. SFX: PHONE DISCONNECTS

77. LULU: (to herself) That man is unbelievable!

78.	ATMO:	CLUB MUSIC HEARD THROUGH THE DOOR
79.	MNENE:	Look, Mukaraba, I'm sorry I couldn't stop that girl
		publishing her story! What else could I have done?
80.	MUKARABA:	(furious) Just make sure nothing like that ever
		happens again, Mnene! Keep a better eye on her
		from now on!
81.	MNENE:	Of course, boss. So what are you going to do about
		the court hearing?
82.	MUKARABA:	Control the damage. I'm giving a big interview on
		the radio tomorrow to convince them that I'm the
		victim here. (laughs) That shouldn't be too difficult.
		I'll just tell them I have faith in our judicial system
		and that justice will prevail! (laughs)

- **103. TINA:** Hey girls! What are you two gossiping about?
- **KW BEGIN**
- 104. SILENCE
- **105. TINA:**(snaps finger) Hello? Hey, what's up? I'm talking to<br/>you!
- **106. MERCY:** Why don't you ask Trudy?
- **107. TRUDY:** Come on, Mercy, I've said I'm sorry.
- **108. TINA:** Hey, what is it? Are you two fighting?
- **KW END**
- **109. TRUDY:** Mercy's still angry with me because of that interview with Mukaraba.
- **110. TINA:**Hey, hey! Fighting won't solve anything! I thought<br/>you two had sorted this out? You need to stick<br/>together!

### 111. TRUDY / MERCY: (silent)

- **112. TINA:**(seriously) Listen: I happen to know, as well, thatMukaraba is not a good man. I'd strongly advise youtwo to keep quiet about the whole thing! At least forthe time being.
- **113. MERCY:** How do *you* know him?
- **114. TINA:** Just ... trust me.
