<u>INTRO</u>

1. NARRATOR:

Hello and welcome back to "Crossroads Generation". We're getting near the end of this third season... This is the 21st of 26 episodes and we're going to start right away. Just a quick recap of what's happened so far: Previously, an accidental encounter with a kind lady in his neighbourhood opened up a whole new world of possibilities for Dan:

2. FLASHBACK: EPISODE 18, LINES 57-59

DAN: Could you teach me how to make those ornaments?OLD WOMAN: (chuckles, surprised) You want to learn knitting?DAN: Yes, please!

3. NARRATOR:

4. FLASHBACK: EPISODE 20, LINES 118, 124, 127

TINA: (almost in tears) Something... something's happened to Trudy. (...) She's... She's... She's dead.

MERCY: (cries) No! You're lying! Trudy's not dead!

5. NARRATOR:

Mercy is devastated. She and Trudy had been friends for a long time, and they'd just started studying journalism at university together. Mercy's still in shock as we start this 21st episode, entitled "Justice for Trudy".

SCENE 1: MERCY AND TINA TALK ABOUT TRUDY'S DEATH

6. ATMO: UNIVERSITY ATMO, INSIDE HOSTEL

KW BEGIN

- 7. MERCY: (cries) Oh no! No! No!
- 8. TINA: Calm down, Mercy, please! Come on, let's sit down over here, on your bed. It's good that you could get back to the university so fast.

9. SFX: BED CREAKING / CLOTHES RUSTLING

- **10. MERCY:** I don't believe it, Tina. It can't be true! Trudy can't be gone!
- **11. TINA:** She is, Mercy. I'm so sorry. The police took her away yesterday. There's nothing we can do...

KW END

12.	MERCY:	(deep breath) Okay, Tina. Tell me: what
		happened? How? I mean
13.	TINA:	The police didn't want to say anything, but the
		students who live in that building say they heard a
		shot.
14.	MERCY:	What??? Trudy was shot? I thought she must have
		had an accident or something?!
15.	TINA:	(bitter) No. This wasn't an accident.
16.	MERCY:	What do you mean?
17.	TINA:	Everybody's saying it was a robbery gone wrong.
		That she was shot by thieves who'd broken into the
		students' hostel. But
18.	MERCY:	(interrupts) What? Thieves? Oh no Maybe I
		could have helped her if I'd been here! (remorseful)
		Oh, why did I have to go see my mother and Linda
		that day! I could have waited until the weekend –
		maybe

- **19. TINA:** Mercy, please, listen to me! I don't think either you or I could have done anything! (urgently, low voice) And I don't think it was thieves who did that to her.
- **20. MERCY:** (startled) What? What do you mean?
- 21. TINA: (serious tone) Mercy, there's something I need to tell you.
- 22. MERCY: (sniffles) What?
- 23. STUDENT LEADER: (heard from outside, far away) We want

justice!

- 24. CROWD: (heard from outside) We want justice!
- 25. STUDENT LEADER: We want security!
- 26. CROWD: We want security!
- 27. TINA: (talking above them) What's that? Sounds like all

the other students are gathering outside...

MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 2: BILLY LAUGHS AT DAN FOR KNITTING

28. ATMO: SLUM ATMO, INDOORS

29. SFX: RUSTLING OF PLASTIC BAGS, KNITTING NEEDLES

30. DAN: (to himself) Okay, this one's done, now, too. I'm

getting faster and better every day! I think my teacher will be very proud! (laughs) Man, if anyone had told me a month ago that I, Dan Kanyama,

would be spending my days knitting...

- 31. SFX: KNOCK ON DOOR
- **32. DAN:** Come in, it's open.
- 33. SFX: DOOR OPENS
- **34. GEORGE:** Hi, Dan!
- **35. DAN:** Hi, George! You're late today.
- **36. GEORGE:** Sorry, Dan. The garbage trucks were late, too. But we managed to get more plastic bags than usual.

Here they are...

37. SFX: RUSTLING OF PLASTIC BAGS

38. DAN: Ah! Great – thank you. Here's your money.

39. SFX: BILLS AND COINS EXCHANGE HANDS

40. SFX: DAN'S CELLPHONE RINGS

- **41. GEORGE:** Cool! See you tomorrow.
- **42. DAN:** Bye! (to himself) Who's calling now...?
- 43. SFX: DOOR CLOSING
- 44. SFX: BEEP AS PHONE IS ANSWERED
- **45. DAN:** Hello?
- **46. BILLY:** (on phone) Hey, Dan!
- **47. DAN:** Billy! Nice of you to call. Where've you been hiding, man?
- **48. BILLY:** (on phone) Just around and about. Listen, are you still looking for a job?
- **49. DAN:** Well... no, not really. Why? Did you find one?
- **50. BILLY:** Yes, I did. Guess what? I'm now an assistant
 - contractor in a big construction company.
- **51. DAN:** Wow! Really? Good for you, man. How did you...?
- **52. BILLY:** My cousin is the boss there. He hooked me up.
- **53. DAN:** Oh, I see.
- 54. BILLY: Listen, the reason I'm calling is that there's a supervisory role on one of our sites, and I suggested you.

- 55. DAN: Oh... Thanks! That's really nice of you. But... I don't know, Billy.
- **56. BILLY:** What do you mean, you don't know?
- **57. DAN:** You see, I really did start my own business. And it looks as if it's going quite well.
- **58. BILLY:** What business? Burrowing in garbage like a rat?
- **59. DAN:** Well... That one didn't quite work out. But I've actually found a way to make women's handbags out of garbage.

KW BEGIN

- 60. BILLY: (laughs) What? So now you stay at home and sew like an old lady?
- **61. DAN:** (uncomfortable) Actually, it's knitting, not sewing.
- 62. BILLY: (bursts out laughing) That's even better!
- 63. DAN: Well, it pays my bills. And I really like it!
- **64. BILLY:** Listen, man! This is the opportunity of a lifetime!

You'll make so much money!

65. DAN: Billy, thank you for the thought, but I think I'll just stick to my bags. I mean, I'm my own boss here...And I've even had an offer of a business cooperation...

KW END

- 66. BILLY: I can't believe this. You're letting a good job go so you can sit at home making handbags?
- **67. DAN:** Billy, I like doing what I'm doing. And besides, it's good for the environment.
- **68. BILLY:** Okay, *'Mr. Environment'* but don't come crying to me when it all goes wrong, okay? (sarcastic laugh)

69. SFX: PHONE IS DISCONNECTED

MUSICAL INTERLUDE

SCENE 3: TINA TELLS TRUDY HER SECRET WHILE STUDENTS GATHER OUTSIDE

- 70. ATMO: INSIDE UNIVERSITY HOSTEL, STUDENTS HEARD THROUGH WINDOW
- 71. STUDENT LEADER: (from afar) We want justice!
- 72. CROWD: (from afar) We want justice!
- 73. STUDENT LEADER: We want security!
- 74. CROWD: We want security!
- 75. STUDENT LEADER: Comrade power!
- 76. CROWD: Comrade power!
- 77. MERCY: (close to mic) Look, Tina, all the other

students are protesting for Trudy!

- **78.** TINA: (close to mic) You're right, Mercy. Let's open the window to see what's going on!
- 79. SFX: WINDOW BEING OPENED

80. ATMO: OUTDOOR ATMO AND STUDENTS' SHOUTING HEARD THROUGH OPEN WINDOW

FLASHBACK: Ep. 22, line 2

81.	STUDENT LEADER:	It seems that robbers can easily get into the
		hostels - and they've killed our friend! This
		cannot happen again! Justice for Trudy,
		security for the students!
82.	CROWD:	Justice for Trudy, security for the students!
83.	STUDENT LEADER:	As a first step, we're going to protect our
		hostels ourselves!
84.	CROWD:	Yes! Comrade power!
85.	STUDENT LEADER:	But we're also addressing all the politicians.
		They lie to us, and make all kinds of promises
		whenever they want to be elected. But once
		they get into power, they do nothing at all
		about the insecurity in our country!
86.	CROWD:	We want security!
87.	MERCY:	Do you know them, Tina?
88.	TINA:	Not all of them.
89.	MERCY:	I think it's great that they are doing this for
		Trudy!
90.	TINA:	Yes, but Mercy, I

91. MERCY: Shh, let me hear what they're saying!

KW BEGIN

- 92. STUDENT LEADER: They are now busy travelling all around,
 - making more false promises in order to get
 - themselves re-elected! Down with the

politicians!

- **93. CROWD:** Down with the politicians!
- 94. STUDENT LEADER: Are we going to allow the politicians to lie to

us again?

- **95. CROWD:** No!
- **KW END**
- 96. STUDENT LEADER: We won't rest until they hear us!
- 97. CRODW: Yes!
- 98. STUDENT LEADER: Comrade power!
- **99. CROWD:** Comrade power!
- **100. MERCY:** Tina, shouldn't we be with them? Maybe that's

the last thing we can do for Trudy!

- **101. TINA:** Wait, Mercy. There is something else we can
 - do. It has to do with why Trudy was killed.

- **102. MERCY:** Right you said you wanted to tell me something about that...?
- **103. TINA:** Close the window.
- **104. MERCY:** (confused) Okay.
- 105. SFX: WINDOW CLOSED
- **106. ATMO: INSIDE UNIVERSITY HOSTEL**
- **107. STUDENTS:**(heard from outside, then fade down) Justice forTrudy! We want security!
- **108. TINA:** (deep breath) Mercy, this has to remain between me and you, okay?
- **109. MERCY:** I promise.

110. TINA: I think Mukaraba was behind Trudy's death.

111. MERCY: Nooo. That can't be it. What does he have to do with anything? Trudy wrote that article about him and the baby ages ago. And he's been found guilty of illegal adoption now – it's all out in the open!

FLASHBACK: Ep. 22, line 4

112. TINA: That's not what I'm talking about. **(sighs)** Trudy came to see me about a story she wanted to do for the student radio. It was about the brothel in town.

- **113. MERCY:** I don't understand --
- **114. TINA:** (interrupts) It's run by Mukaraba.

115. MERCY: What? How do you know?

- 116. TINA: Well, I told you about my job... remember? We're not supposed to know, but I'm sure Mukaraba's the one behind that racket! I've heard him in the office several times, talking to Mister M. He's the one who speaks on his behalf...
- **117. MERCY:** Tina, are you sure?
- **118. TINA:**Yes. At first, I didn't want Trudy to do the
investigation. But then I decided to help her. I was
her source! We got some pretty explosive material.
She was just about to write her report...

KW BEGIN

- **119. MERCY:** Tina! What did you get yourselves involved in?
- 120. TINA: I wanted to tell people the truth about Mukaraba!And I wanted to help all the other girls who are being treated so badly!
- **121. MERCY:** But... This puts you in danger, too!

122. TINA:	If they knew that I was Trudy's source, they would
	have done something about it by now. They don't
	know. And they won't find out. I've quit my job there.
	I'm not going to work as a call girl any more.
123. MERCY:	What? Wow! That's great! But still, I mean what if
	they found something at Trudy's place that gave
	you away? You just said it was really explosive
	material!
124. TINA:	It is. (deep breath)
KW END	But Trudy didn't have it with her. I've got it right
	here. And I'm going to make sure it gets broadcast!
125. MERCY:	What??? This is too dangerous, Tina! You have to
	get rid of it! You've seen what's happened to our
	friend!
126. TINA:	(interrupts) I owe it to Trudy. And to be honest I
	could use your help.
127. MERCY:	(gasps)
