Osama's father wants him to become an Islamic holy warrior

Koran studies instead of math, combat exercises instead of soccer training. All part of a regular day for Ayman (12) and Osama (13). The two brothers are growing up in Syria and being prepared for a future as Islamic holy warriors. At least this is the wish of their father, Al-Nusra rebel leader Abu Osama, whose ultimate goal is the establishment of a caliphate. To make the award-winning documentary **Of Fathers and Sons**, director Talal Derki returned to his homeland. Posing as a Salafist sympathizer, Derki was able to gain the trust of a radical Islamist family and document their everyday life over a period of two years. The film opens an illuminating window on a world normally hidden from the public gaze.

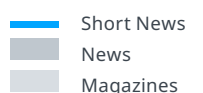
