### Rising from the Ashes

Notre-Dame, the most famous cathedral in Paris, was on fire! The shock report that made global headlines on 15 April 2019. The extent of the damage was huge, but before long it was clear: Notre-Dame must be saved! Restoration work has been going on ever since and in 2024, the cathedral is set to reopen its doors. Germany is supplying some of the reconstruction expertise. The "Kölner Dombauhütte" or Cologne Cathedral Workshop is restoring four large glass windows; working on around 100 square meters of colored glass. **Euromaxx** shows just how much painstaking craftsmanship goes into repairing the beautiful windows of Notre-Dame.

Jewish twins Adam and Ida Paluch were three years old when they were separated by the Nazis in 1943. In desperation, their mother took her own life. Adam was taken to a concentration camp, while Ida was able to hide. Both children survived the Holocaust and were adopted by Polish families after the war. It would be 53 years before the two would find each other again. Now, for the first time in their lives, Adam and Ida have shared their story with a German film crew. Theirs is an incredible story about the life-long search for identity, loss and a yearning to belong. **Adam and Ida – Almost a Fairytale** – the documentary on DW.
