Reclaiming History

April 1994: In Rwanda, the parents of two year old Samuel Ishimwe are murdered. They were just two of some one million people who, over the course of several months, were brutally killed in the genocide of the country's Tutsi minority. Thirty years later, Samuel wants to know the reasons why. He sets out on a search for clues that takes him from Rwanda to Germany and Belgium. Both nations are former colonial powers of the small East African nation. Does this mean they may bear some responsibility for the terrible events that befell Samuel's homeland? A question explored in the documentary **Reclaiming History – Colonial Roots of the Genocide in Rwanda**.

Education for All! But How?

Nothing less than their future is at stake: Emilija Dorne and 20,000 other school children sing the Latvian national anthem at the tops of their voices. The students are protesting Latvian government plans to close or rebuild schools in smaller towns and villages. The move comes in response to a lack of money, teachers and pupils in many locations across this EU nation. For Emilija, the reform would mean a 30-kilometer commute to a school in a larger town. **Global Us** appraises the situation in Latvia and other countries worldwide in terms of literacy, equal opportunities for girls and the chances of advancement through education.

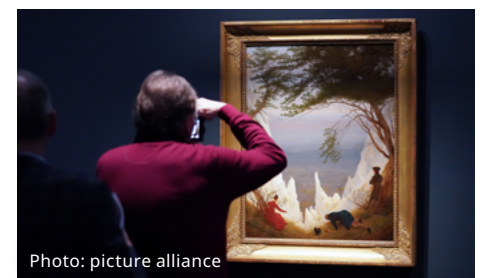

North Korea – geographically diminutive, but geopolitically often the center of global attention. The nation is isolated, and its population impoverished. The country has been in the iron grip of the Kim dynasty for three generations – a family dictatorship in the guise of a communist system. Propaganda, intimidation and surveillance are the pillars of North Korean society. These clandestine structures remain hidden from most. Nevertheless, the Kim dynasty also wields global power.
