Description

A notable aspect of the disinformation problem in Kenzania is the emergence of a "disinformation for hire" industry. This involves individuals or groups who are paid to create and spread false or misleading information online. These entities often use social media platforms to disseminate their content, taking advantage of the viral nature of these platforms to reach a wide audience quickly. The motives behind this industry are varied but often include political manipulation, where parties or candidates seek to influence public opinion or discredit opponents. It can also be driven by commercial interests, where businesses use disinformation to undermine competitors or promote their own products or services.

As a part of Russia's policies in countries of the former Soviet Union, state and affiliated actors are attempting to destabilize Moldorgia by sowing dissent between the Moldish and Russian speaking segments of the population. People are targeted on Telegram, in Russian-speaking social networks and media. The narrative suggests that Russian-speaking people are treated as second-rate citizens and that pro-EU politics is compromising the independence of the country.

Banglamar is experiencing increased polarization and factionalism between Buddhist and Muslim segments of its population. The UN has stepped in and created camps as safe havens for Buddhist people. These camps for internally displaced persons experience widespread rumors and disinformation that stress the differences and antagonisms rather than the commonalities of these religious communities.

Description

Presidential elections are coming up on the island of Tongji. The past years have seen a continuous rise in right- as well as left-wing populism in the country, with politicians providing their supporters with half-baked facts about the status quo of the nation and questionable accounts of what the political opponent intends to do. The population is confused and anxious. There have been first incidents of violence between opposing factions, sparked by false accusations.

Description

Erithiopia is torn apart by civil war with armed conflicts between various ethnic groups. At the same time, there is an information war. All parties to the conflict are trying to discredit their opponents through media manipulation and false reports. To make matters worse, the surrounding neighboring states are interfering in this conflict at all levels, e.g. by disseminating their own narratives on platforms like YouTube and TikTok. Videos, some of them Al generated, are targeting the foreign actors. In one example an Al version of President-elect Bami Mabed was produced endorsing attacks on politicians from the opposition party.
