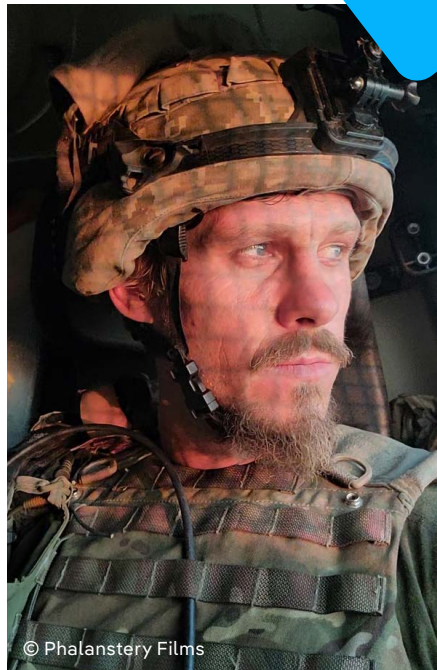

Marilyn Monroe: The Blonde Icon's Secret

She was the sex symbol of the 1950s and bore a secret that didn't align with her image: Marilyn Monroe was a Latina. Her mother Gladys Pearl Baker was born in Piedras Negras, Mexico. Marilyn herself was born in Los Angeles in 1926 but retained close links with Mexico due to her heritage. Why did she conceal her Mexican roots throughout her life? **Arts Unveiled** tells the story of the hidden Latina as the world marks the 100th birthday of Marilyn Monroe on 1 June 2026. The global star died in 1962 at the age of 36.

Nikola Tesla – Waves of the Future

He invented technologies that shape our world to this day: Nikola Tesla. The electrical pioneer arrived in New York in 1884 with barely a cent to his name. He worked briefly for Thomas Edison before the two parted ways amid a dispute. He later developed two-phase alternating current, conducted research into wireless power transmission and recognized the importance of solar energy, visions far ahead of their time. Despite holding over 280 patents, Tesla died alone and penniless in a New York hotel in 1943. The documentary **Nikola Tesla – Waves of the Future** depicts the eventful life of one of the world's greatest inventors.
